OUR "12 GREAT DATES WITH YOUR DAUGHTER" PROGRAM DEALS WITH THE MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS OF TEEN GIRLS IN LOUDOUN. IN TWELVE DIFFERENT "DATES," TEENS (WITH THEIR FAVORITE ADULT) DISCUSS THE GOOD, BAD, AND UGLY ISSUES FACING TEEN GIRLS TODAY SUCH AS DATING, BULLING AND SELF-IMAGE WITH FACILITATED DISCUSSIONS LED BY COMMUNITY PROFESSIONALS. IN 2018, WE SERVED 77 TEENS IN THIS PROGRAM. OUR "WHAT'S YOUR WORD" PROGRAM ENABLES GROUPS OF TEENS TO DISCUSS WHO THEY ARE AND WHAT THEY WANT IN LIFE. THEY CHOOSE A WORD TO SET THEIR INTENTION AROUND A GOAL OR STATEMENT ABOUT THEMSELVES AND THEN MAKE A BRACELET WITH THAT WORD. IN 2018, WE SERVED 35 TEENS IN THIS PROGRAM.
