Based upon a generous local foundation grant received in 2017, Presbyterian SeniorCare was able to develop and implement a career pathways program in collaboration with middle and high schools to create awareness of healthcare careers in senior services and long-term care. In 2018, two programs were piloted at the Oakmont and Washington campuses: The Youth Engagement Pathways (YEP) summer volunteer program for teens 13 to 16 and the High School Career Pathways program, a curriculum-based initiative in partnership with three Pittsburgh Public Schools (Carrick, Perry and Westinghouse) and in Washington County, Trinity High School and Western Area Career and Technology Center (WACTC). Additionally, Presbyterian SeniorCare received a generous local foundation grant that has supported the development and implementation of a phased rollout of Dementia360, a new Presbyterian SeniorCare program that extends dementia care management into the home setting to support family caregivers who are caring for persons with Alzheimer's disease and related dementias. hospitalizations and delay nursing home placement while enhancing the
