AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

HANDS OF CHRIST, A DULUTH COOPERATIVE MINISTRY, INC.

ITEM I

The name of the corporation is:

HANDS OF CHRIST, A DULUTH COOPERATIVE MINISTRY, INC.

<u>ITEM II</u>

The Corporation is organized pursuant to the provisions of the Georgia Non-Profit Corporation and shall have perpetual duration.

ITEM III

The date of adoption of the Amendment by the Board of Directors was April 26, 2018.

ITEM IV

Approval of Members is not required, as Members have no vote, and the Amendment was approved by a sufficient vote of the Board of Directors.

ITEM V

The Board of Directors further agree that the Articles of Incorporation shall be amended and restated in their entirety as follows:

Article 1. Name

The name of the corporation is:

DULUTH COOPERATIVE MINISTRY, INC.

Article 2.

The corporation is organized pursuant to the provisions of the Georgia non-profit corporation code.

Article 3.

The corporation will have members who shall be defined in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

Article 4.

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a board of directors. the method of electing the board of directors shall be determined by the Bylaws of the Corporation.

Article 5.

The mailing address of the initial principal office of the corporation is 3395 Fox Street NW, Duluth, GA 30096.

Article 6.

The initial registered office of the corporation is 3395 Fox Street NW, Duluth, GA 30096 in the County of Gwinnett. The initial registered agent of the corporation is Margy McLynn.

Article 7.

Personal liability of all directors and members of the corporation to the corporation or its members from monetary damages for breach of duty of care or other duty as a director is hereby eliminated to the extent allowed by O.C.G.A. §14-3-202(b) of the Georgia non-profit corporation code or any successor statute.

Article 8.

The corporation is not organized and shall not be operated for pecuniary gain or profit.

No part of the property of the corporation and no part of its net earning shall inure to the benefit

of or be distributable to any director, member, or other private individual. The corporation shall never be authorized to engage in a regular business of a kind ordinarily carried on for profit or in any other activity except in furtherance of the purposes stated above for which the corporation is organized.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of attempting to influence legislation, by propaganda or otherwise. The corporation shall not participate or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on or behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Article 9.

In the event of the dissolution of the corporation, to the extent allowed under applicable law, after all lawful debts and liabilities of the corporation have been paid, all assets of the corporation shall be distributed to, or its assets shall be sold and the proceeds distributed to another organization organized and operating for the same purposes for which the corporation is organized and operating, or to one or more corporations, funds, or foundations organized and operating exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, recreational or educational purposes, which shall be selected by the Board of Directors of the corporation; provided, however, that any such recipient organization or organizations shall at that time qualify as exempt from taxation under the provisions of 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as an organization described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provisions of any subsequent law. In the event that upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors of the Corporation shall fail to act in the manner herein

provided within a reasonable time, a court of competent jurisdiction in the county in the principal office of the corporation is located shall make such distribution as herein provided upon the application of one or more person s having a real interest in the corporation or its assets.
