**GRANT #1 - In February 2018 the organization was awarded a Grant from the National Endowment for Democracy (Grant 2018-0248) for the amount of \$120,300. The purpose of the grant is to continue to support the organization's work promoting greater interaction between pro-democracy, pro-human rights activists and regular citizens that seek solutions for community problems. The grant was awarded as part of a grant between NED and the US Dept of State. In 2018 we received \$100,300 and "line 10" amounts paid were \$91,130**

**GRANT #2 - In June 2017 the organization received a grant from the International Republican Institute (IRI), an award from the United States Agency for International Development, (USAID Award AID-AAA-A-16-0040) for the provision of humanitarian assistance to political prisoners in Cuba and their families. The USAID program is planned for 36 months until 2019. In 2018 the organization received \$56,000 and line 10 amounts paid were \$28,820**

**GRANT #3 - In July 2017 the organization received a grant (also through the IRI) from the United States Dept of State International Programs to support Democracy, Human Rights and Labor (DRL Federal Award S-LMAQM-16-GR-1161, dated Aug 23, 2016). The DRL program was for an amount of \$62,000 over a period of 12 months but was extended (no cost extension) until Aug 30, 2018. In 2018 the organization received \$17,950 from this DRL grant to help organize Cuban small farmers to advocate for their civil and labor rights. The line 10 amounts paid were \$9,596.**

**GRANT #1 - For the NED program, a total of 28 Civic Centers were supported with laptop computers, printers, digital phones, and printing supplies, as well as internet access (wi-fi minutes) for reporting and communications. The goal of the program is to assist and empower citizens to assert their civil and human rights by filing cases with local officials regarding instances of neglect, arbitrary home evictions and other human rights issues. During 2018 an average of 20 cases per trimester were presented to local authorities. In addition some of the Civic Centers also print a bulletin (a 2 page newsletter) for dissemination in their respective provinces. In 2018 about 40% of the the Civic Centers printed the newsletter for dissemination in their respective provinces. Details of the activities performed are reported in quarterly reports narrative and financial reports to the grantor.**

**GRANT #2 - For the USAID program (Humanitarian Assistance to Political Prisoners and their families), a total of 128 families of current or former political prisoners (or other persecuted and marginalized citizens) were assisted in 2018 with delivery of food supplies and simple over the counter pharmaceuticals and vitamins. The shipments are made as a supplemental aid to the families with each family receiving aid approximately every 3 months. Commodities shipped are from a list approved by USAID following guidelines of the US Dept of Commerce. A detailed order by order status (and to whom) is monitored in quarterly reports required by the grantors (USAID / IRI)**

**GRANT #3 - The IRI / US Dep of State program to help Cuban farmers begin to organize ended in July August of 2018. Two groups (one with approx 20 farmers in western Cuba and a smaller in central Cuba) had been organized to discuss and learn and demand basic civil & labor rights including the opportunity to sell their products in the open market instead of being forced to sell only to the government at a lower price. Mentoring and training had been provided by agricultural experts from Guatemala in 2017. In 2018 mentoring and support continued via email and phone. The project supplied laptops, telephones and internet time o facilitate interaccion between the farmers.**
