MR. AND MRS. WILLIAM BRYANT WERE UNAWARE THAT THE FOUNDATION'S RETURNS FOR 2017 AND 2018 WERE NOT FILED. THE FOUNDATION'S ACCOUNTING FIRM ALWAYS HANDLED PREPARING THE FORMS 990-PF IN THE PAST AND SENT THEM TO THE BRYANT'S FOR FILING, BUT THE FIRM HAD FAILED TO DO SO FOR THE TWO YEARS INDICATED ABOVE. THE BRYANT'S FAILED TO REALIZE THESE RETURNS WERE NOT FILED BECAUSE THE ACCOUNTING FIRM HAD BEEN SO RELIABLE IN THE PAST.

ONCE MR. AND MRS. BRYANT RECEIVED IRS NOTICE CP259B RELATING TO THE 2018 RETURN, THEY IMMEDIATELY DISCOVERED THE 2017 RETURN WAS ALSO NOT FILED. THEY CHANGED THE FOUNDATION'S ACCOUNTING FIRM AND HAD THE FORMS PREPARED BY THE NEW FIRM.
