County, Montana. The property protected consists of 1,443 acres. The easement was assigned to MLR by an Assignment of and
Second Amendment to Conservation Easement that was recorded on April 6, 2018, as Doc. #177283, records of Madison County, Montana.
The easement was assigned to MLR for future monitoring and enforcement and the legal description was amended to correct an inadvertent
error in the original and first amendment documents.
2) Mountain Sky Guest Ranch This 6,294 acre property in the Paradise Valley was protected by a Deed of Conservation Easement
recorded on January 5, 2018, as Doc. #401856, records of Park County, Montana. That document contained an inadvertent typographical
error with regard to the correct year of the transaction, mistakenly stating the year as "2017" instead of the correct "2018" date, which
resulted from the original expectation of the parties that recordation of the easement would occur in late 2017 rather than early 2018. The
Correction of Deed of Conservation Easement was recorded on May 2, 2018, as Doc. #403423, records of Park County, Montana.
3) Endicott Amendment this easement (protecting 604 acres) was originally donated by the Craig siblings on December 16, 2002, recorded
at Doc. #3031445 (Book M27, Page 5820), and corrected by a "Correction of Deed of Conservation Easement and Notice of Exercise of
Reserved Rights Under Deed of Conservation Easement" recorded on March 4, 2014, as Doc. #3255212 (Book M48, Page 2697), records of
Lewis & Clark County, Montana. On November 7, 2018, the "Ratification and Amendment of Deed of Conservation Easement" was recorded
as Doc. #3330052 (Book M54, Page 8987). This amendment affected only the 422-acre parcel owned by William Craig and sold to
the Endicott family in 2015. The amendment reduced the number of permitted development areas on the 422-acre parcel from two to one;
shrunk the development footprint from five acres to three acres; reduced the number of permitted structures within the development area;
sited the development area in a location that offered significantly greater protection of the conservation values; and eliminated the
reserved right of the landowner to maintain, repair, remodel, and made limited additions to the existing homestead structures on the parcel.
This ratification and amendment further enhanced, protected, and preserved the conservation values of the property in perpetuity and
thereby enhanced the public benefits of the easement.

and Jerry Townsend. These two individuals provide oversight of the funds that MLR invests in the Foundation to further its conservation
efforts across the state of Montana. There are a total of six Directors on the Foundation's Board that provide such oversight.

Through an Intercorporate Services Agreement, MLR provides accounting/bookkeeping and administrative support to the MLR Foundation.
In 2018, these services amounted to \$36,000. The MLR Foundation Board of Directors also approved a grant request from MLR in the
amount of \$423,471 in 2018. The grant covered costs related to the monitoring/enforcement of the 872 conservation easements held by
the organization; costs related to completion of conservation easements in 2018; and costs related to education and outreach
activities to the general public, other organizations, and government agencies.
(5) MLR staff provides, through an Intercorporate Services Agreement, investment and tracking support to the Ruby Habitat Foundation.
The President of MLR's Board of Directors and two MLR staff members serve on the Board of Directors of the Ruby Habitat Foundation
to provide oversight. These costs in 2018 were \$6,000.
(7) MLR purchased a Deed of Conservation Easement on the 4,443-acre "Askin Parcel" of the larger Ringling Ranch for \$558,000. Staff was

negotiating the transaction with Paul Ringling (the father of MLR former officer Rock Ringling), and sadly Paul passed away prior to
the transaction being finalized. The easement purchase was completed by the estate of Mr. Ringling; Rock Ringling and his sister, Ann,
were the co-personal representatives of the estate.
