Montana Conservation Voters, Inc.'s primary exempt purpose is to educate and activate voters to be vital and effective participants in Montana's democratic process, to protect air and water quality, public health, fish and wildlife and open space. MCV informs the public about the votes and actions of local, state and federal elected officials pertaining to conservation and environmental issues, and encourages their involvement in government.

Form 990, Part III, Line 4a - Program Service Accomplishments

Outreach and Community Organizing: The 2018 election cycle was a pivotal one with huge victories won on local and state elections. MCV was in the field early with one of the largest canvass teams in the state and knocking on 49,142 doors made the difference for winning on local issues - like the Missoula County Open Space Bond/City Stewardship Levy and opposing the water bottling plant in the Flathead - and in key legislative districts. We identified conservation-minded voters, educated them on where candidates stand on conservation issues and we mobilized our voters to participate on election day.

MCV's four chapters, Yellowstone County, Gallatin-Park County, Missoula County and Flathead County each convened membership meetings attended by an individual low of 20 members and a high of 80. Chapter boards meet approximately nine times per year.

Conservation Policy Campaign: MCV's 2018 Conservation Policy Campaign was dedicated to working with the Bullock Administration and the state legislature on a pro-active Energy Blueprint and Public Lands Agenda. Specific areas of work in 2018 included:

- 2) Working with candidates for the 2019 Montana State Legislature to educate them about pending proposals to advance clean, renewable energy and energy efficiency, public lands protection, as well as clean water laws and measures to ensure broad-based citizen participation, while opposing roll backs.
- 3) Opposing proposals to transfer federal lands to the state as well as the dedication of any state funds to study this.
- 4) Continuing work during the 2017-2018 interim legislative period by testifying before the Interim Energy and Telecommunications Interim Committee regarding clean energy policies.
- 5) Coordination of meetings of the Conservation Working Group, a coalition of groups organized to advocate for strong environmental policies post-election and pre-session to establish legislative policy priorities.
- 6) Recruiting and securing appointments of conservation and environmental group leaders to openings on relevant local and statewide boards and commissions.

As a member of the Public Lands working group, MCV prepared a strategy to promote a potential ballot initiative for the 2020 ballot to create a public lands financing program similar to the federal Land & Water Conservation Fund (LWCF).

As a member of the Clean Energy working group, MCV primarily focused on net metering and other clean energy related issues. Setting priorities for the 2019 session grew complicated due to a study commission by the PSC under the requirements of HB219

which passed in 2017. The idea of the bill was to determine if net metering customers were being reimbursed too much for the energy they generate relative to their ability to utilize the electricity grid when the sun isn't shining. The clean energy group agreed to move forward with legislation increasing the cap of net metering systems from 50kw to 1Mw and also an aggregate net metering bill. Other issues discussed include ways to promote and increase the use of energy storage technologies, a statewide energy efficiency requirement, increasing the requirements of the renewable energy standard, and addressing contract lengths for Qualified Facilities (OFs).

MCV, working with a coalition of conservation organizations, successfully advocated to the Bullock Administration the need to enforce the bad actor provision of state law regarding Hecla Mining's proposal to mine underneath the Cabinet Mountain Wilderness. Hecla's president, Phillips Baker, Jr. was the chief financial officer for Pegasus Gold when it filed for bankruptcy and closed the Zortman-Landusky mine south of the Fort Belknap Indian Reservation. Because Pegasus has not fulfilled its remediation obligations, under Montana's bad actor provision, Baker, and therefore Hecla, cannot apply for a new hardrock mining permit until either Baker is no longer associated with Helca or the remediations obligations are met. MCV joined allied groups to intervene on DEQ's behalf after Helca filed a lawsuit challenging the interpretation of the bad actor law.

MCV worked with consultants to capitalize on successful past efforts in Montana to minimize the significant threats to Montana's progress made from the new administration and Congress by:

1. Demonstrating public support for environmental regulations and laws, while

mobilizing volunteers against attacks from the Trump Administration and Congress.

- 2.Built short, medium and long-term capacity to win local and state climate fights and environmental battles.
- 3.Organized and developed members, volunteers and partnerships using Climate
 Action Montana techniques and online tools while developing a unique Climate Action
 Montana narrative in the media.
- 4. Applied a racial justice lens where it could be incorporated in our program.
- 5. Advanced our best practices with data and knowledge available to the program.

As it does each year, MCV released the national League of Conservation Voters'
Congressional Scorecard in February 2018 with a press release and earned media
efforts in the statewide and local press. MCV also completed rigorous social media
and digital efforts to disseminate the message to a broad audience.

In the summer and fall of 2018, MCV chapter leaders and staff prepared non-partisan questionnaires mailed to candidates running for the statewide, legislative, and local offices and invited them to participate at chapter membership meetings. MCV also communicated with members about what was at stake in the 2018 elections and provided voter information to residents of these communities about the environmental positions of those who responded to questionnaires.

effectively utilize MCV's new database.

Ongoing staff development included participation in monthly League of Conservation Voters Development Director calls, Political Director calls, monthly organizing calls and participation at LCV's Executive Director meeting which included a staff development component. MCV staff carried out their professional development plans including legal compliance issues, civic engagement, environmental policy and fundraising skills.
