Community Organizing, Outreach and List Enhancement: MCV has continued to play in a role in the Montana Engagement Project (MEP), which serves as the collaboration between the Greater Yellowstone Coalition, Montana Wilderness Association, and Montana Wildlife Federation, and MCV. This partnership was created as a long-term communications and grassroots strategy designed to leverage popular support for shared values (such as public lands, clean water, wildlife, and rural/ag heritage) to create broad change in Montana that will lead to durable conservation and clean energy policies.

the legislative session began in 2019. We shared these priorities with elected officials by hosting educational conference calls before the session and inviting CWG members to participate as well.

Conservation Policy Program: At the state level, MCVEF has a robust public policy and public education program related to public education and building support for policies to be pursued by the 2019 Montana State Legislature, including policy accountability and pre-session work.

As the facilitator of the Conservation Working Group (CWG), MCVEF worked with over 20 state conservation partners to create a policy agenda for the 2019 legislative session which includes three proactive bills focused on providing energy investment opportunities through commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy, reforming the Public Service Commission procedures to provide more transparency and investing in Montana's state parks and trails through a new funding mechanism via an additional voluntary vehicle registration fee. MCVEF has also worked to ensure CWG is ready to prevent rollbacks of exiting public safeguards, wildlife protections and environmental standards during the legislative session.

MCVEF also continues to provide additional public policy services, including analysis of state legislative proposals; preparation and distribution of briefing papers; coordination of meetings with allied conservation and environmental groups; and weekly meetings with legislative allies and staff of the Governor's office.

At the federal level, MCVEF coordinated the Climate Action Coalition, working in partnership with the national League of Conservation Voters Education Fund and over

Additionally during 2018, MCVEF worked to keep Senator Steve Daines accountable on his support of the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) through a multi-pronged campaign that included radio, newspaper ads, consistent social media posts, a radio piece and a billboard.
