Rapid Response Campaign - LCF established rapid response fund to support in the recovery and rebuilding of Latino, immigrant communities impacted by the recent natural disasters that have largely affected these communities. In 2017, LCF established the Just Recovery initiative supported by the NorCal Wildfire funds. The funds have been invested in local groups working towards a just and equitable recovery and rebuilding.

- 4b (Code) (Expenses \$ 1,150,899 including grants of \$) (Revenue \$)

Strengthen Civic and Economic Power of Latinos (Empower) - Convene, unite, and leverage network of Latino-led organizations to increase civic engagement amongst Latinos and work towards a stronger, more inclusive democracy and economy. The goal is to empower Latino community leaders, youth, and families to engage civically and politically. Ultimately, LCF seeks to double the number of Latino voters across California within the next 10 years.

Build a Movement of Philanthropic, Civically Engaged Latinos (Inspire) - Inspire a culture of philanthropy by and for Latinos through cultivation of individual donors, including the establishment of Giving Circles throughout California. The goal is to increase Latino philanthropy to increase investments in Latino-led Orgs and build a new narrative of Latinos. By 2028, LCF seeks to leverage and invest at least \$25 million in Latino-led organizations.
