In the fall of 2018, following the devastation caused by Hurricanes Florence and Michael, the Booz Allen Foundation responded again by making donations to local nonprofits that were providing disaster response and recovery support to individuals, leverage the Foundation's donation, (5) had nondiscriminatory policies/practices, and (6) were in good standing with the IRS. For all donations made, the Foundation required written confirmation and acknowledgement. At three and six months after the donation, the Foundation haskwill reach back to each

organization to receive an update on program activities undertaken.
