**1. United Kingdom Program support of convenings, research and collaborations**  
**- \$517,931**

Projects brought together funders, non-profits, and outside experts; funded field-wide research; increased the resilience of the field; facilitated alliances; and enabled collaborations.

Strategic development and collaboration

- a. Organizational development to strengthen the resilience of organizations through fundraising, board restructuring, management consultancy, or strategic support. For example a pilot program to increase online fundraising for 10 smaller charities using a bespoke platform.
- b. Commissioned reports and workshops on scenario building, strategy, and strategic communications. One commission supported a project exploring strategic communications initiatives in the UK, bringing together work done in other public policy fields (poverty, housing, child safety) on framing and communications with those working on refugee and immigration issues.
- c. Research commissions including a longitudinal study into immigration attitudes.

Events and convenings

Over 13 major convenings including roundtables, small group meetings, seminars, overnight training and networking events, and contributions to costs of conferences and public events. All were intended to connect the field with new allies, each other, and with philanthropy and covered a wide range of issues including vulnerable European nationals, youth-led activism, women's rights, and pop culture.

Civic Muslim voices

Funded work on attitudes by and towards Muslims, on integration and for strategic communication projects such as bringing Jewish and Muslim communities closer together through grassroots women's groups; engaging with anxious audiences on issues related to Islam, refugees, identity, and migration; and build alliances with others engaged with identity and integration challenges.

**2. United States Program support for research, convenings and connecting grantees - \$298,894**

Projects brought together funders, non-profits, and outside experts; funded field-wide research; increased the resilience of the field; facilitated alliances; and enabled collaborations.

Culture Change Strategy Project

Dissemination of a segmentation study of over 2,500 people, asking them questions about immigration beliefs, concerns, political views, and demographic characteristics. The findings have generated extensive discussion and interest among philanthropic partners and field leaders.

#### Family Immigration Research and Education Project

A brief for funders describing the current legal immigration system and the administration's efforts to reduce future migration flows.

#### Uncovering New Approaches to Anti-Hate Work Project

Shared strategy recommendations from a 2017 commission of landscape research to help funders and advocates understand how to counter the growing influence of nativist and White nationalist groups. A convening of diverse anti-bigotry researchers and frontline activists developed field strategy to implement the recommendations.

#### Protecting Asylum Seekers

Hired two asylum experts to draft a research memo on how funders can respond to the crisis of people fleeing violence in Central America.

#### Convening and Connecting Our Grantee Partners

- Supported 100 key partners in Washington, DC for a day-long convening to plan a response to the anticipated changes to the "public charge" rules, which govern how the potential use of public benefits affects individuals' ability to enter the country or to adjust to lawful permanent resident status. Participants broke out into working groups (federal advocacy, policy/legal, field, research, communications) for discussion and planning, and identified major priorities for the next six months. A key goal of the campaign was to delay the publication of the final rule until after the 2020 elections and lessen the harm of the proposed policy changes by generating tens of thousands of comments. The campaign far exceeded its ambitious goal by successfully generating more than 200,000 public comments, with the vast majority opposing the rule change.
- Brought together 89 participants from 14 states to help strengthen relationships between Black and Asian immigrant youth leaders and build a shared analysis to their work. In a follow-up evaluation of the convening, 78 percent of participants noted that they learned new information about the other community. This is particularly significant given that 60 percent of respondents indicated that they spend little to no time with people of other communities on a daily basis.

#### Learning exchanges

- A learning exchange in Washington DC from April 7 to 12, hosted by Church World Service. CWS works with refugees and immigrants to build stronger and more welcoming communities. The program facilitated collaboration and sharing of information and insights about best practices in community-based organizing; examined the specific contribution that faith-based organizations can make in the current policy climate and how to best mobilize this effort; enhanced the ability of participants to identify and develop effective communications strategies; supported participants in identifying potential approaches and allies in their work; and identified common opportunities and challenges to inform future strategies. It brought together 10 participants from England, Scotland, and Ireland to meet with practitioners, activists, and strategists from the US.
- A learning exchange in Washington DC from June 16 to June 21, hosted by America's Voice, an organization working to harness the power of American voices and American values to enact policy change that guarantees full labor, civil, and political rights for immigrants and their families. The theme of the exchange was effective strategies to frame and communicate issues relating to immigration and refugee protection for advocates and activists working with policy-makers, politicians, and the public. The program was designed to offer a mix of skills training and broader practice information and discussion for communications staff working in NGOs in the UK, Ireland, Germany, and Italy.

### **3. Executive Director Discretionary Program support for research, convenings and connecting grantees - \$23,625**

Activities included:

#### Communications trainings

A strategic communications training for Long Island nonprofits. The aim of this training was to provide these smaller organizations with the skills to:

- Establish a clear understanding of their target audiences and communications priorities
- Learn framing and messaging best practices to reach and activate their target audiences
- Learn how to engage journalists effectively
- Learn interview tips and techniques to strengthen their skills and build their confidence
- Carry out follow-up communications activities such as supporting directly impacted community members in writing and publishing their stories in ways that tie into and elevate current media debates.

#### Other technical assistance to enhance the effectiveness and sustainability of the field

This included additional communications support; monitoring, evaluation and learning activities; and fundraising consultancy.

#### Convenings and workshops

Supported the field to remain engaged and be responsive through resourcing organizations and individual leaders to travel and participate in convenings or meetings.

### **4. Migration Learning Exchange Program - \$151,922**

Activities included:

- a. A learning exchange in Dartington, South-West England from October 17 to 19, hosted by Counterpoints Arts, an arts organization that engages with refugee and migrant experiences through arts and cultural programs. The aim of the exchange was to facilitate new cross-sector collaborations and explore the potential of popular culture to catalyze social change, especially in relation to migration and displacement. There were over 60 attendees from the UK, US, and Europe spanning fields of philanthropy, immigration, film, music, TV, literature, journalism, community development, and digital activism.
- b. A learning exchange in New York City from November 5 to 9, hosted by the Center for Court Innovation, a public/private partnership between the New York State Unified Court System and the Fund for the City of New York that creates operating programs to test new ideas and solve problems, performs original research to determine what works (and what doesn't), and provides expert assistance to justice reformers around the world. The theme of the exchange was to explore how law and activism can interact to create lasting social change. A cohort of Justice First Fellows, trainee attorneys based in the UK learnt from and networked with US based non-profits, academics, and legal professionals.

- c. Preparation and administration costs for America's Voice to host a learning exchange in Washington DC focusing on strategic communications and messaging in the immigration fields in both the US and UK.

## **5. Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning - \$26,960**

Activities included:

### Educational briefs

Co-produced a handful of briefs to share learning on topics that we are frequently asked about by other funders, such as the European refugee crisis, narrative change, cultural change, and women's rights activism. The purpose of these briefs is to share what we have learned and to offer insight into how funders may enter an area of work that may be particularly complex or of interest.

### Funder landscape survey

Commissioned a survey of other foundations to map out the funding landscape in the US around immigration. The results of this survey were presented by Steven LaFrance at funder collaboratives.

### Interviews with US grantees

Supported evaluation interviews with select grantees which produced valuable insights that were shared with funder groups. The interviews incorporated funding partners' requests about topics they are interested in.
