Part 1 Line 1 - Every 4 to 6 months a ministry called Rescue Training and Development Center (RTDC) picks 10 young, destitute woman from
villages in Nepal that have been recommended by various pastors and brings them to Kathmandu, Nepal. RTDC helps educate them and
teaches them how to sew and run a seamstress business. We pay for the room, board, and tuition for those 4 months. During this time they
are also taught the love Jesus Christ has for them. At the end of 4 months, they return to their villages to begin their businesses. We are now
on our 23rd group of students and have had 220 students graduated with a very high success rate in their businesses. One of our board
members travels to Nepal and attends the graduation every 5 months or so and also visits past students and we are in constant contact
with the directors of RTDC who send us regular updates and pictures of the students and their progress. www.nepairtdc.org.
We have also involved ourselves with sending some older orphan children whom we have some personal knowledge of to university
in Nepal, India and the Philippines by paying room, board, and tuition. Some of these students are from orphanages that we have supported
in the past, while others are children of indigent people whom we know personally. These students are also followers of Christ and are
committed to sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ. We monitor their progress via email, personal visits while visiting Nepal, and
communicating with their parents, pastor or orphanage parents.
Part 1 Line 2 - Frontier Lodge is a ministry in Alberta, Canada dedicated to sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ, using creation as the way
to share the gospel with those participating in the programs. Some of the staff at Frontier lodge grew up being part of our Sunday Church
Services and participated in ministry here. They are likeminded with us in purpose and attended the same Bible School as one of our
Board of Directors did. We monitor the ministry through a board member personally visiting the ministry once or twice a year and through
emails and phone calls.
Part i, ii, iii - Selection of Organizations and individuals we support - The organizations which we select have leadership that agree with
our purpose, mission, and doctrinal statements and are followers of Jesus Christ Someone from our ministry needs to have personally
met these leaders. They have not requested grants from us, but rather must be presented to the board by someone from our ministry that
knows them The Individual orphans that we pay tuition, room, and board for, have been children in orphanages we have supported in the
past or are from indigent families that we know personally. Our emphasis is finding individuals that we know are committed followers of
Christ so that the gospel of Jesus Christ will be propagated and disseminated through various avenues of their employment in the future
