NEXT GENERATION ALLIANCEThe Palau Association's Next Generation Alliance (NGA) was formed to identify, affirm, equip, and mobilize an international fellowship of evangelists. In 2018, this fellowship grew to 750 members. Under the motto "One Message, Many Expressions," NGA members use many means and methods to proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ--including festivals, neighborhood outreaches, action sports, music, creative arts, multimedia and the Internet. Included in the effort were neighborhood clean-up projects, home revitalization projects, and a massive "feeding of the 5,000" "Only God could have done this," Cross said "At every opportunity God provided us with what we needed--sometimes before we even knew we needed it. We had no money, no budget, nothing. It's about going beyond what we're capable of doing as humans " This appears to be the beginning of a new season of ministry and outreach for the United Kingdom While in England the Palau team met with dozens of leaders in a handful of cities. From Birmingham to Wolverhampton, Bristol to SW London, each group had the same desire--to see the Church come together to proclaim the Good News on a massive scale in their community4 CITIES TOUR // OCTOBER 2018The Palau team traveled throughout the U K in The 4 Cities Tour to unite with pastors and leaders who are passionate about pointing their communities to Jesus, and interested in beginning preparations for future evangelistic festivals. Additionally, Andrew shared the Good News with many who had never heard the Gospel Four cities and 8 evangelistic events, helped launch an evangelistic movement in the region. The team traveled to Edinburgh, London, Bristol, and Birmingham, encouraging and uniting hundreds of faith leaders, speaking to local media and in churches, and building relationships with local business and civic leaders. Highlights of the trip included joining with more than 120 key national leaders in London as part of the U K -wide initiative for evangelists called Advance 2020 to hear the vision and strategy of the movement, a powerful night of worship and prayer with hundreds of people, and the beginning planning meeting between Wendy Palau and Lady Susie Sainsbury for a women's outreach in May 2019 The visit also began the discussion with leaders in the area about hosting a region-wide evangelistic festival in 2020 Additionally, Andrew joined with musicians Martin Smith and Daughters of Davis for a powerful night of worship and a message of hope.
