There was no associated unrelated business income tax benefit for the year ended December 31, 2017. The Federation does not have any significant uncertain tax positions for the years ended December 31, 2018 and 2017. On December 22, 2017, the President signed into law H.R. 1, originally known as the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act. The new law includes several provisions that result in substantial changes to the tax treatment of tax-exempt organizations and their donors. The Federation has reviewed these provisions and the potential impact and concluded the enactment of H.R. 1 will not have a material effect on the operations of the organization.
