28 DURING THE YEAR ENDED MARCH 31, 2019, THE DEATH WITH DIGNITY POLITICAL FUND PROMOTED THE OREGON LAW AS A MODEL FOR OTHER STATES ACTIVELY SEEKING TO PASS DEATH WITH DIGNITY LAWS. THERE IS AMPLE EVIDENCE DEATH WITH DIGNITY LAWS WORK AS INTENDED, BASED ON MORE THAN 20 YEARS OF SUCCESSFUL IMPLEMENTATION IN OREGON, A DECADE IN WASHINGTON STATE, AND SIX YEARS IN VERMONT. THIS FLAWLESS TRACK RECORD, COMBINED WITH A GROWING NUMBER OF STATES ADOPTING AID-IN-DYING LAWS, HAS GROWN SUPPORT FOR END-OF-LIFE POLICY REFORM NATIONWIDE. IN MARCH 2019, THE NEW JERSEY LEGISLATURE BECAME THE EIGHTH JURISDICTION TO PASS A DEATH WITH DIGNITY LAW, AND THE FIFTH TO DO SO SINCE 2015. A CLEAR INDICATION THE DEATH WITH DIGNITY MOVEMENT IS GAINING MOMENTUM AND RAISING AWARENESS ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF PROVIDING A RANGE OF MEDICAL OPTIONS FOR INDIVIDUALS IN THE FINAL STAGES OF A TERMINAL ILLNESS. THE DEATH WITH DIGNITY POLITICAL FUND LENT ITS LEGAL AND POLITICAL EXPERTISE TO GRASSROOTS CITIZENS, LEGISLATORS, AND END-OF-LIFE EXPERTS THIS YEAR. THE PROGRAM SUPPORTED ACTIVITIES IN MAINE, MARYLAND, NEVADA, NEW MEXICO, AND NEW YORK. IN MAINE, WE HELPED FORM A GRASSROOTS POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE, MAINE DEATH WITH DIGNITY, AND WORKED WITH STATE-BASED ADVOCATES TO GATHER MORE THAN 70,000 SIGNATURES TO PLACE A DEATH WITH DIGNITY MEASURE ON THE 2020 STATE BALLOT. IN TANDEM, WE WORKED WITH MAINE LEGISLATORS TO DEVELOP A STRATEGY FOR MOVING A BILL THROUGH THE STATE LEGISLATURE. WE STRENGTHENED OUR MULTI-YEAR RELATIONSHIPS WITH LAWMAKERS AND LOBBYISTS IN NEVADA AS WE PUSHED FOR PASSAGE OF A LAW, PROVIDED TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO GRASSROOTS ADVOCATES IN NEW MEXICO, AND SENT EXPERTS TO TESTIFY AT LEGISLATIVE HEARINGS IN MARYLAND AND NEW YORK.	28a	78,954
