Assistance League Scholarships awards college scholarships to seniors graduating from Santa Ana Unified School District's Career Technical Education Program (CTE). Students must have teacher recommendations, the desire to attend either a 4-year college or a community college, and a financial need. Scholarships are paid after verification of enrollment on a semester or quarter basis. Many recipients are the first in their family to attend college. Each year at least 20 scholarships are awarded and presented at a spring reception at the Assistance League facility for the recipients' families, teachers, principals, and SAUSD quests.

The Monthly Food Pantry and Food Distribution program operates during Santa Ana Unified School District school breaks providing monthly emergency food pantry services to hungry Santa Ana families consisting of dry food such as rice, pasta, beans, canned soups, canned mixed vegetables and corn, peanut butter, jelly, tuna fish and cereal. The Food Distribution programs take place during SAUSD school breaks - winter, spring and summer and provides dry food and cooking needs such as cooking oil as well as fresh food such as garlic, onions, tomatoes and fruits such as apples, oranges, strawberries and bananas.
