MENTOR Vermont, Inc. BY LAWS

Article I. NAME

Section 1.01 NAME. The name of the Corporation shall be "Chittenden County Mentoring Project, Inc. (Amended to Mobius, Inc. on 9/5/2003, Amended to MENTOR Vermont on 9/11/2019)

Article II. PURPOSE

Section 2.01 PURPOSE. The purpose of the Corporation shall be to increase the number of high quality mentoring relationships in the State of Vermont by creating a culture that supports and encourages mentoring, and by nurturing the growth of existing programs and/or building additional capacity through the creation of new programs. The Corporation is organized solely and exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes, and the corporation shall not carry out any activity not permitted to be carried out by a corporation exempt from Federal income taxation under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future Federal tax code).

Article III. BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Section 3.01 QUALIFICATIONS. The Board of Trustees shall consist of not more than twenty-five (25) Trustees and not fewer than nine (9) Trustees. Such other number may be authorized by an amendment to these by laws. At no point shall there be fewer than three Trustees who are affiliated with mentoring service provider programs as directors, trustees, or program coordinators. At no point shall Trustees who are affiliated with mentoring service provider programs constitute a majority of the board. The Board shall seek and support initiatives to the end that the Board of Trustees reflects the cultural diversity of the community and includes current and former recipients of mentoring services.

Section 3.02 TERM. Each Trustee shall serve from the date of his or her election at an annual meeting until the third annual meeting after the date of his or her election. Board membership shall be limited to two consecutive terms, but after a lapse of one year, reelection to the Board is permissible. This Bylaw may be waived by a majority vote of the Board, when the continued service of a Trustee beyond two consecutive terms is deemed to be in the best interest of the corporation. Any Trustee elected between annual meetings to fill a vacancy shall be elected for the unexpired term of his or her predecessor in office and shall be eligible, at the conclusion of the term, for reelection to a full three year term. For the initial Board, this Bylaw shall be waived so that the terms of the Trustees shall be divided equally, more or less, into one, two, and three year terms. For the initial terms of the Trustees appointed as affiliates of mentoring service provider programs, this bylaw shall be waived and the terms shall be divided equally, more or less, into one, two and three year terms, to ensure a rotating pattern of succession and turnover.

Section 3.03 DUTIES AND POWERS. Except as set forth in these Bylaws, the Board of Trustees shall establish general policy and oversee the property and business of the Corporation.

The Board shall be responsible for the employment and annual evaluation of an executive director. The Board of Trustees may adopt such rules for the conduct of their meetings and the management of the Corporation as they deem proper, not inconsistent with law or the Bylaws.

Section 3.04 RESIGNATION. Any Trustee may resign at any time by delivering to the Secretary written notice of such resignation; unless otherwise specified therein, such resignation shall take effect immediately.

Section 3.05 VACANCIES; REMOVAL. Any vacancy in the Board of Trustees arising between Annual Meetings may be filled by the affirmative vote of a majority of the remaining Trustees. Any trustee who is absent from three of any six consecutive meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be eligible for dismissal from the Board. The tenure of any member who is eligible for dismissal may be terminated by majority vote of the Trustees present and voting at any regular meeting or at a special meeting of the Board called for that purpose.

Section 3.06 COMMITTEES. The Board of Trustees, by resolution adopted by a majority of the Board of Trustees, may designate from among its members one or more other committees each of which, to the extent provided in such resolution and allowed by law, shall have and may exercise all the authority of the Board of Trustees in the management of the business and affairs of the Corporation. Each committee shall keep regular minutes and report to the Board of Trustees.

Section 3.07 HONORARY TRUSTEES. The Board of Trustees may, at its option, elect by majority vote at any time an honorary director whose term shall expire within one year from the date of election and whose term may be annually renewed indefinitely at the option of the Board. An Honorary Trustee shall not have voting rights, but shall enjoy all other prerogatives of Board membership.

Article IV. MEETINGS

Section 4.01 ANNUAL MEETING. The annual meeting of the board of trustees for the election of trustees and the transaction of such other business as may properly come before such meeting shall be held at the principal office of the corporation (or at such other location as the board of trustees may determine) as shall be designated in each year by the President of the Corporation. At the annual meeting, the trustees shall elect Officers from among their number and assign to them such duties and responsibilities as the board shall determine and as set forth in these Bylaws.

Section 4.02 REGULAR MEETINGS. Regular meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be held at least quarterly at such place and time as shall be established by the President in his/her discretion. The Secretary or his/her designee shall give notice of the meeting to each Trustee in writing at least 72 hours before the meeting. All Board meetings shall be open to the public, except when the Board determines the need to convene in Executive Session.

Section 4.03 SPECIAL MEETINGS. A special meeting of the Trustees may be called by the President or at the request of four (4) members of the Board of Trustees. Notice of such meeting shall be given in the same manner as for regular meetings.

Section 4.04 PARTICIPATION IN MEETINGS BY ELECTRONIC MEANS. Trustees and members of any committee may participate in a meeting of the Trustees or committee by means of communications equipment such that all persons participating in the meeting can communicate with each other. Participation in a meeting in such a manner shall constitute presence of the person at the meeting.

Section 4.05 ACTION WITHOUT A MEETING. Any action required or permitted to be taken at any meeting of the Board of Trustees may be taken without a meeting if all the members of the Board consent thereto in writing and such writing or writings are filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the Board.

Section 4.06 QUORUM. At every meeting of the Board of Trustees, the presence of a majority of the Trustees in office shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at that meeting.

Section 4.07 VOTING. Each Trustee shall have one (1) vote on the Board of Trustees.

Article V. OFFICERS

Section 5.01 ELECTION AND TERM OF OFFICERS. The Board of Trustees shall elect the officers of the Corporation from its membership. There shall be a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. The officers shall hold office for one year commencing upon the conclusion of the Annual Meeting and until their successors are chosen and qualified, unless sooner removed by a majority vote of the Board.

Section 5.02 PRESIDENT. The President shall preside over all meetings of the Board of Trustees. He/she serves as ex officio member of all committees. He/she performs all duties normally incidental to the office and such other duties as may from time to time be indicated by the Board of Trustees.

Section 5.03 VICE PRESIDENT. In the event of the absence, incapacity or inability of the President to perform his/her duties, the Vice President shall exercise the power of the office of the President. The Vice President shall also have such power and perform such duties as may from time to time be assigned by the Board of Trustees.

Section 5.04 TREASURER. The Treasurer shall have the primary responsibility for the oversight of all funds and securities of the corporation. The Treasurer shall report to the Board of Trustees regarding the financial condition of the corporation at least quarterly or when otherwise requested.

Section 5.05 SECRETARY. The Secretary shall be responsible for keeping minutes and records of the meetings of the Board of Trustees, give notice thereof and perform other duties

incidental to said office as may be required by law, regulation or request of the Board of Trustees.

Section 5.06 ADDITIONAL OFFICERS. The Board of Trustees may, from time to time, designate and appoint such other officers as, in its judgment, the business of the Corporation may require. The Board of Trustees must specify the duties and powers of such officers and may remove them at its discretion.

Article VI. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Section 6.01 APPOINTMENT. The Board of Trustees shall employ an Executive Director who shall be under the direction of the Board of Trustees and who shall be the general executive officer of the Corporation.

Section 6.02 EVALUATION. As stated in Section 2.03, the Board shall evaluate the Executive Director's performance annually.

Section 6.03 DUTIES.

- a) The Executive Director shall carry out the objectives and purposes of the Corporation, and shall be responsible for execution of the program approved by the Board of Trustees and performance of duties and obligations as determined by the Bylaws, policies and decisions of the Board.
- b) The Executive Director shall be responsible to the Board for the management of the business of the Corporation.
- c) The Executive Director will meet with and advise the Board and Committees.

Section 6.04 AUTHORITY. The Executive Director shall have authority to select employees to fill positions and to dismiss employees consistent with the terms of any applicable employment contract and the Corporation's personnel policies and procedures. The Executive Director shall have the authority to negotiate for grant and contract funding from both public and private sources. The Executive Director shall have the authority to carry out the objectives and purposes of the Corporation and the duties placed on him or her by the Board of Trustees.

Section 6.05 EXPENDITURES. The Executive Director may cause to be made all regular expenditures within the duly adopted budget. The Executive Director shall make regular reports or cause regular reports to be made to the Board covering the following and such other matters as may be pertinent to the work of the Corporation: the performance of program and service functions, the Corporation's relationship with the community, the Corporation's financial status and the extent to which the work is being carried out within the limits of the budget, as well as the needs which call for additional expenses.

Section 6.06 TERMINATION. The Executive Director may be terminated by a two thirds (2/3) vote of the membership of the Board of Trustees.

Article VII. INDEMNIFICATION

Section 7.01 GENERAL. Unless otherwise provided in the articles of incorporation, the corporation shall indemnify any individual made a party to a proceeding because the individual is or was a Trustee of the corporation, against liability incurred in the proceeding, but only if the corporation has authorized the payment in accordance with §8.55 of the Vermont Nonprofit Corporation Act and a determination has been made in accordance with the procedures set forth in §8.55 of the Vermont Nonprofit Corporation Act that the Trustee met the standards of conduct and other requirements set forth in paragraphs 6.2.1, 6.3 and 6.4, below.

Section 7.02 STANDARD OF CONDUCT. The individual shall demonstrate that:

- a) The Trustee conducted himself or herself in good faith; and
- b) The Trustee reasonably believed:
 - i. In the case of conduct in his or her official capacity with the corporation, that his or her conduct was in the corporation's best interests;
 - ii. In all other cases, that his or her conduct was at least not opposed to the corporation's best interests; and
 - iii. In the case of any proceeding brought by a governmental entity, the Trustee had no reasonable cause to believe his or her conduct was unlawful, and the Trustee is not finally found to have engaged in a reckless or intentional unlawful act.

Section 7.03 NO INDEMNIFICATION PERMITTED IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES. The corporation shall not indemnify a Trustee under this Article:

- a) In connection with a proceeding by or in the right of the corporation in which the Trustee was adjudged liable to the corporation; or
- b) In connection with any other proceeding charging improper personal benefit to the Trustee, whether or not involving action in his or her official capacity, in which the Trustee was adjudged liable on the basis that personal benefit was improperly received by him or her.
- Section 7.04 INDEMNIFICATION IN DERIVATIVE ACTIONS LIMITED. Indemnification permitted under this Article in connection with a proceeding by or in the right of the corporation is limited to reasonable expenses incurred in connection with the proceeding.
- Section 7.05 ADVANCE EXPENSES FOR TRUSTEES. If a determination is made, following the procedures of §8.55 of the Vermont Nonprofit Corporation Act that the Trustee has met the following requirements; and if an authorization of payment is made, following the procedures and standards set forth in §8.55 of the Vermont Nonprofit Corporation Act, then, unless otherwise provided in the articles of incorporation, the corporation shall pay for or reimburse the reasonable expenses incurred by a Trustee who is a party to a proceeding in advance of final disposition of the proceeding, if:
 - a) The Trustee furnishes the corporation a written affirmation of his or her good faith belief that the Trustee has met the standard of conduct described in this Article;
 - b) The Trustee furnishes the corporation a written undertaking, executed personally or on his or her behalf, to repay the advance if it is ultimately determined that the Trustee did not meet the standard of conduct (which undertaking must be an unlimited general obligation of the Trustee but need not be secured and may be accepted without reference to financial ability to make repayment); and

c) A determination is made that the facts then known to those making the determination would not preclude indemnification under this Article or Chapter 8, Subchapter 5 of the Vermont Nonprofit Corporation Act.

Section 7.06 INDEMNIFICATION OF OFFICERS, AGENTS, VOLUNTEERS AND EMPLOYEES WHO ARE NOT TRUSTEES.

- a) Unless otherwise provided in the articles of incorporation, the Board of Trustees may indemnify and advance expenses to any officer, employee, volunteer, or agent of the corporation, who is not a Trustee, to the same extent as a Trustee.
- b) Each request or case of or on behalf of any person other than a Trustee who requests indemnification, shall be reviewed by the Trustees and indemnification of such person shall be authorized by the Trustees only if it is determined by the Trustees that indemnification is proper in the specific case.

Section 7.07 MANDATORY INDEMNIFICATION. Unless limited by the articles of incorporation, a corporation shall indemnify a Trustee and an officer of the corporation in accordance with §8.52 and §8.56 of the Vermont Nonprofit Corporation Act.

Section 7.08 INDEMNIFICATION ONLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Article, no person shall be indemnified to the extent, if any, that a court of competent jurisdiction determines that indemnification is contrary to applicable law.

Section 7.09 INSURANCE. The corporation may purchase and maintain such insurance on behalf of any person who is or at any time has been a director, officer, volunteer, employee or other agent of or in a similar capacity with the corporation, or who is or at any time has been, at the direction or request of the corporation, a director, trustee, officer, volunteer, administrator, manager, employee, member, shareholder, advisor or other agent of or fiduciary for any other corporation, partnership, trust, venture or other entity or enterprise including any employee benefit plan against any liability asserted against and incurred by such person. Notwithstanding the foregoing, no individual for whom indemnification is intended hereunder shall be indemnified for any cost or liability for which coverage and reimbursement are provided under an insurance policy.

Article VIII. AMENDMENTS

Section 8.01 AMENDMENT. These By laws may be amended at a meeting of the Board of Trustees called for this purpose, fourteen days' notice of said meeting having been given in writing either by mail or personal service upon, or delivery of the same to each member, or left at their usual place of abode by the President or Secretary. The text of all proposed changes must be provided with said notice. A two thirds (2/3) vote of the membership of the Board of Trustees is necessary to amend.

Article VIII. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section 9.01 CHECKS, DRAFTS ETC. All checks, drafts or orders for payment of money, notes or other indebtedness issued in the name of the Corporation or in the name of any special committee shall be issued only in accordance with standard accounting procedures.

Section 9.02 EXECUTION OF INSTRUMENTS. Subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees, the President may enter into contracts or execute and deliver any instruments in the name and on behalf of the Corporation. The Board may authorize any other Officer or Agent to enter into any contract or execute and deliver any instrument in the name and on behalf of the Corporation. Any such authorization may be general or limited to specific contracts or instruments.

Section 9.03 CONTRACTS. The Corporation shall not, except by vote of 2/3 of the Board of Trustees, enter into any bond or surety, security, bail or co signer relationship for any person, persons, partnerships or corporations which would permit any corporate property to be attached or taken on execution.

Section 9.04 FISCAL YEAR. The fiscal year of the Corporation shall commence July 1, and shall terminate on June 30, unless otherwise fixed by resolution of the Board of Trustees.

Section 9.05 BOOKS. The books of the Corporation shall be kept at the principal place of business in Chittenden County, State of Vermont. Each Trustee shall have the right to inspect said Corporate books at any reasonable time.

Section 9.06 FUNDS AND DONATIONS. The Corporation is hereby empowered to raise funds for its charitable purposes. The Corporation shall keep accurate records, books, and other necessary documentation, in appropriate accounting form, of all grants, donations, bequests, or other contributions to the Corporation and shall report such contributions to the Internal Revenue Service as the IRS may, from time to time, require.

Section 9.07 DISSOLUTION OF THE CORPORATION. In the event of dissolution of the Corporation, its assets shall be allocated to a 501(c)(3) organization with a similar purpose chosen by the Board of Trustees.

Section 9.08 BOARD COMPENSATION. Trustees shall not be compensated for serving on the Board of Trustees. Trustees shall be entitled to reimbursement of expenses incurred on behalf of the corporation if such reimbursement is approved in advance by vote of the Board.
