At that time, it was discovered that there were items on the balance sheet of which the current PTA was unaware of their nature or why these accounts had balances. During FYE2018 & 2019, an extensive research and investigative approach was taken to review old records and inquire of any person who might have been involved during those years to see if they knew of any true liabilities or grants. These balances pre-dated the PTA's migration to using Quickbooks, which occurred in 2010. There were no entries to any of these accounts subsequent to these initial balances being set up. According to a balance sheet that was located for August of 2008, the PTA had \$0 liabilities. Therefore, we know that the creation of these items occurred during the period between August 2008 and the migration to Quickbooks in 2010. We were unable to find any definite answers or ascertain more information from any former PTA members. It is impossible for us to determine with any certainty the cause for these transactions. Our best guess is that someone was attempting to track funds for certain purposes and did
