Expenditures for capital building projects include transfers of \$674,500 in cash for the new Saginaw Center and land valued at \$488,600 for the new Midland Center. These donations were transferred to the College to support construction of two new educational centers. The new centers are replacing aging facilities with state-of-the-art technology in centrally located downtown areas, making the new facilities close to public transportation and more accessible to the students they serve. Students living in these communities will have the opportunity to earn a degree in several programs very close to home. The new Saginaw facility opened in August 2019 with an enrollment of 624 students. The new Midland center is expected to open in 2021.

Expenditures for educational purposes include transfers of donated cash, equipment and classroom supplies. These transfers to the College were used to enhance educational programs and provide the College's students with scholarships and awards. The Foundation also published and distributed two issues of a magazine, Journeys, which highlighted Delta College programs and events and provided valuable information about the educational opportunities available to residents in the Great Lakes Bay Region. These expenditures benefitted the entire College community of 12,300 students and staff and the residents living in the surrounding communities.

Expenditures for endowments include cash transfers to the Delta College Endowment Fund for investment. Income generated by the Endowment Fund provided approximately 380 scholarships and awards during the year. It also supported numerous programs such as the President's Scholar, the Possible Dream, the Dow Foundation STEM Education Programs and numerous endowed teaching chairs. These scholarships and programs benefitted the entire College community of 12,300 students and staff and the residents living in the surrounding communities.

Expenditures for non-academic student assistance included payments to utility companies, car repair shops, grocers and landlords totalling \$18,480. This aid was provided for the benefit of Delta College students attending classes who were at risk of not completing their courses due personal crises. All of the students who received aid were referred by College staff and payments were made directly to the service providers. This assistance helped approximately 107 students.

Form 990, Part V, Line 7h:

Two automobiles were donated to the Foundation by car dealerships. These vehicles were part of their sales inventory and since auto sales is their "ordinary course of business" we were not required to issue Forms 1098-C. These vehicles were transferred to the College's Technical Trades and Manufacturing Division to teach auto mechanics to students in this curriculum.

The Foundation financial statements are reviewed by the entire Board of Directors each quarter. At the end of the year, the completed Form 990 is distributed to the Board members selected to serve on the Finance Committee. The committee members task is to review the information contained on the Form 990 and the required schedules and to prepare for a meeting with the Executive Director, the Treasurer and the Accountant, who completes the Form 990. This meeting provides the committee members with an opportunity to question, amend and approve the content of the Form 990 prior to submitting it to the IRS. The members of the committee will report back to the full Board of Directors at their next scheduled quarterly meeting.
