In school Mentors and our staff Student Advocates work together to oversee and address student needs and concerns. The staff maintains communication with family. The staff assures that all tuition and expenses have been paid We strive to invite an equal number of young women and young men into the program. These students are eligible for renewed support each year by achieving strong grade results in Division 1 or 2, maintaining positive discipline in school and communicating actively with mentors and staff The Board feels a responsibility to support each student we have in our program until he/she becomes a productive member of society We have funds that will allow each of our student to go through higher education if the student follows our guidelines. Our funds have been carefully built to handle our financial obligations to these students. We will invite new students only when we know we can support them for at least six years of their education. As a part of this program, our students write letters to share their educational experiences and illustrate aspects of their Acholi culture with their sponsors and others in the USA. This sharing of cultures is a positive aspect of our project Among our "pioneer" students, there are four nurses, a teacher, a computer technologist and a water/sanitation engineer Two certificate graduates have returned to pursue diploma programs. We have two men studying to be doctors planning to graduate in 2021.
