

For example, certain coverage fees to physicians, cost of Medicare C and D, and other similar direct patient care expenses are specifically excluded as allowable cost in the cost reports. Using the same methodology to calculate the unreimbursed cost of providing charity care and Medicaid (using applicable Schedule H Worksheets) would result in a shortfall of \$22,609,878, which is \$16,561,740 higher than the shortfall reported on Part III, Section B, Line 7. The organization believes that all of the shortfall should be considered as a community benefit for the following
	reasons. First, the IRS Community Benefit Standard includes the provision of care to the elderly and Medicare patients. IRS Revenue Ruling 69-545 provides, in part, that hospitals serving patients with governmental health benefits, including for example Medicare, is an indication that the hospital operates for the promotion of health in the community. paying the full cost for the care of Medicare beneficiaries. 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


