During the fiscal year ended June 30, 2019 the Hospital provided over 3,100 days of hospital services. The nursing home provided over 31,000 resident days during the year. The Hospital also provides community care and services through many healthcare activities and programs provided to support the community. The median household income is about \$42,000. Approximately 45% of the population has a household income below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines. Approximately 29% of the population is covered by Medicaid, 35% by Medicare, 2.5% by CHIP and about 14% uninsured. Additionally, another 3% of the population is covered by Indian Health Services. The entire service area is considered rural and has been designated a health professional shortage area for all primary medical care, mental health and dental. In addition, the entire service area is designated as a medically underserved area. Northern Montana Hospital is the only local hospital in its service area; however there are 3 critical access hospitals, 4 rural health clinics, 3 community health clinics and 3 IHS-Tribal clinics within its service area. The nearest hospital is a critical

access hospital and is 35 miles away.

More than 50% of Northern Montana Hospital's governing board consists of various local business people who reside within our service area and are not employed or contracted by the organization. Northern

The grant was awarded to address prevention, treatment and recovery in rural and remote areas which include the Northern Montana Hospital Service area. Shane Jenson, APRN, Pain Management Provider, and Susan Morgan, RN, Clinic Director, have participated in training in Lewistown to develop opioid use treatment at NMHA facilities. This training allows participating facilities an opportunity to bring providers and resources together s o they can help develop an OUD treatment implementation plan. NMH has established a multi- disciplinary team to address Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT). MAT includes the use of specific medications in combination with counseling and behavioral therapies to provide a "whole-patient" approach to treatment. NMH has two MAT-waived providers. A MedSafe was ins talled in the foyer of the second floor of Northern Montana Hospital. MedSafe is a disposal system for unused and expired medication. This system accepts controlled (Schedules II-V), non-controlled and over-the-counter medicines and meets the requirements of the DEA Con trolled Substances Act. Our promotion of MedSafe through press releases, website and Faceb ook postings increases public awareness about the dangers of prescription misuse and the i mportance of proper storage and disposal of unused medications.
