The Davidson Institute Young Scholars Program is an individualized, intensive program for profoundly intelligent children. Each month during the year, all qualified applicants (between the ages of 5 and 16) are admitted into the Davidson Young Scholars Program. There is currently no limit on the number of Young Scholars selected each year.

To be eligible for the Davidson Young Scholars Program, applicants must demonstrate extreme intellectual precocity by one or more of the following measures:

A score in the top .001% of their age-peers in a particular domain, as measured by an intelligence or achievement test specified by the Institute (e.g., the Stanford-Binet Intelligence Scale).

Evidence of precocity as illustrated by demonstrating mastery of a significant amount of content in a particular domain, far beyond the norm for the child's age group.

Other demonstration of the ability to function at the level of a Talented adult in a specific academic domain.

The Davidson Institute, the Young Scholar, and his/her parents work as partners to develop and implement an individualized plan for the Young Scholar. Young Scholars and their parents may also get together yearly at one of the Davidson Institute sponsored gatherings to connect with peers, share experiences, and learn from each other. Throughout the year, Young Scholar families stay connected with online seminars, private websites, chat rooms and list servers.

As of June 30, 2019, 3,915 Young Scholars and their parents were assisted through the Young Scholars Program.

The Davidson Institute for Talent Development holds two summer programs: Davidson Summer STARS and Davidson THINK Summer Institute.

Davidson Summer STARS provides young, profoundly gifted students the opportunity to attend a five day residential program focused on supporting their academic and social needs. Davidson Summer STARS holds two identical program sessions, proceeding and following the Young Scholar Summit (an annual gathering for Davison Young Scholars and their families).

Davidson Summer STARS participants attend academic sessions taught by Davidson Academy instructors. They also attend academic field trips on or near campus, in addition to participating in social, team-building activities. Participants stay in the university's residence hall, which is staffed by program staff members 24 hours a day. Students share a room with other program participants.

Academic sessions and field trips are different every summer. Academic sessions for 2019 included "The Physics of Motion," "Mythology Makers Writing Lab," and "Statistics and Aviation." 2019 field trips included the DeLaMare Library, Earthquake Seismology Lab, and a visit from the Raptor Outreach program with Animal Ark.

To be eligible to register for the Davidson Summer STARS, participants must be part of the Davidson Young Scholars program and be between 8 to 12 years old.

The program fee of \$1,190 covers room and board and cost of the planned program activities. Participants are responsible for transportation to and from the program, and pocket money. Scholarships based on financial need are available.

The Davidson Institute THINK Summer Institute is a three-week residential summer program on the campus of the University of Nevada, Reno for 13- to 16-year-old gifted students, offering them the opportunity to access an extremely rigorous educational experience. THINK students are enrolled in university-level courses taught by University of Nevada, Reno professors and earn six college credits. Participants

stay in the university's residence hall, which is staffed by program staff members 24 hours a day. Students share a room with other program participants.

The courses for the THINK Summer Institute are different every summer. Courses for summer 2019 included: Introduction to Economics, European Civilization, Introduction to Computing, Introduction to Cultural Anthropology, Introduction to Public Health Biology, and Introductory Calculus for Business and Social Sciences. All participants select two courses. This program runs for three weeks each July.

To be eligible for the THINK Summer Institute, applicants must be 13 to 16 years old during the program and a United States citizen or permanent U.S. resident living in the United States. Applicants must submit a SAT or ACT score and receive a positive teacher nomination (see eligibility criteria at <a href="https://www.DavidsonGifted.org/THINK-Summer">www.DavidsonGifted.org/THINK-Summer</a>). Visit the SAT (<a href="https://www.collegeboard.com">www.collegeboard.com</a>) or ACT (<a href="https://www.actstudent.org">www.actstudent.org</a>) testing websites to register. There is a \$50 non-refundable application fee.

The goal is to keep tuition affordable and it is usually below the cost of comparable camps. The tuition of \$3,900 covers course credits, textbooks, room and board and the cost of the planned program activities. Additionally, participants are responsible for transportation to and from the program, and pocket money. Scholarships based on financial need are available.

In furtherance of its objective to serve gifted youth, the Davidson Institute for Talent Development operates a tuition-free, public school for profoundly gifted middle and high school students. Davidson Academy is a "university school for profoundly gifted pupils" that was established pursuant to legislation enacted by the Nevada Legislature in 2005 (NRS chapter 392A). Davidson Academy is located on the campus of the University of Nevada, Reno and has an enrollment (as of Spring 2019) of 156 students and 33 Online students. Students are admitted solely on the basis of meeting certain minimum criteria set forth in the Nevada statute. The majority of the students also participate in other programs of the Institute such as the Young Scholars program. Although designated as a public school, Davidson Academy will only receive less than one third of its operating budget from public sources (the state of Nevada).

During the 2018-2019 academic year, Davidson Academy operated an Online campus, with the goal of serving profoundly gifted pupils who reside outside the State of Nevada. Davidson Academy charges out-of-state students of the Online campus an annual tuition of \$15,000 per year. Scholarships based on financial need are available. During the 2018-2019 academic year, which extends from August through May, Davidson Academy provided instruction to 33 Online students ranging in grade from  $8^{th}-12^{th}$  grade.

The Davidson Institute Fellows Award Ceremony is a one-day event held in Washington, DC to recognize and honor young people selected as Davidson Fellows who will receive either a \$10,000, \$25,000 or \$50,000 scholarship commitment to further the development of their talent through attendance at an accredited academic institution of learning.

The purpose of this event is to recognize the outstanding achievements of highly intelligent young people who have demonstrated the development of their talents with a significant piece of work. This award program seeks to recognize and award the truly extraordinary in recognized areas of science, technology, mathematics, literature, philosophy, and music as well as "outside the box" ideas. Each submission must be a piece of original work recognized by experts in the field as "significant" and it must have the potential to make a positive contribution to society. Each submission is evaluated on its scope and quality, level of significance and the applicant's depth of knowledge and understanding of the work and the related domain area.

Once the independent team of judges, who are professionals with expertise in the domain areas submitted, have identified a small group of finalists, each finalist is named as a Davidson Fellow and receives either a \$10,000, \$25,000 or \$50,000 scholarship, as determined by the judges using the selection criteria. Individuals named as Davidson Fellows are then honored at an awards reception in Washington, DC. Travel and other hotel costs are paid by the Davidson Institute for Talent Development. Typically, 17 to 20 Davidson Fellows are selected each year. The Davidson Fellows Award is not a competition, but rather recognition of extraordinary achievement.
