OVERWHELMINGLY WELL RECEIVED BY THE UNITED WAY VOLUNTEERS AND THE AGENCIES THEMSELVES, THESE VISITS OFFERED US THE OPPORTUNITY TO PEEK INTO THE EXPERIENCE AN AGENCY CLIENT HAS AS OUR DONOR'S DOLLARS ARE DEPLOYED TO CREATIVELY AND PROFESSIONALLY MEET THEIR NEEDS. ONCE OUR REVIEW OF THE PAPER APPLICATIONS AND THE AGENCY FINANCIAL DATA AND OUR SITE VISITS WERE COMPLETED, WE BASED OUR FUNDING DECISIONS ON A CLEAR CUT RUBRIC THAT GUIDED OUR DISCUSSIONS, ALLOWING US TO MAKE THOUGHTFUL DECISIONS ABOUT THE LIKELIHOOD OF REAL IMPACT FOR THOSE IN OUR COMMUNITY MOST IN NEED. THE RESULT, UNITED WAY OF THE BLUE MOUNTAINS FUNDS HIGHLY QUALIFIED PROGRAMS THAT LEAD TO POSITIVE OUTCOMES. HOWEVER, IT WAS AGREED BY THE UNITED WAY OF THE BLUE MOUNTAINS BOARD THAT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 (SPRING 2019) ALLOCATIONS, ALL AWARDEES OF THE PREVIOUS YEAR WOULD RECEIVE 50% OF THEIR PREVIOUS AWARD.
