TIMELY PAYMENT OF ANNUAL DUES IS A REQUIREMENT OF MEMBERSHIP. FULL MEMBERS MAY PARTICIPATE IN ALL ASSOCIATION SPONSORED ACTIVITIES AND MAY VOTE. PARENTS, LEGAL GUARDIANS, SPONSOR, AND TEACHERS WHO ARE FULL MEMBERS ARE ELIGIBLE TO BE NOMINATED FOR, AND TO HOLD ELECTIVE OFFICE, SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS OF THE BYLAWS. OHANA MEMBERSHIP CONSISTS OF ALL OTHERS WHO DO NOT QUALIFY FOR FULL MEMBERSHIP AND WHO SUPPORT THE OBJECTIVES AND POLICIES OF THE ASSOCIATION TIMELY PAYMENT OF DUES IS A REQUIREMENT OF MEMBERSHIP. UNIT COUNCIL INCLUDES ONE PARENT PER GRADE LEVEL, ONE TEACHER PER GRADE LEVEL, AND THE PRINCIPAL AND VICE PRINCIPAL, OR THEIR DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVES. THE MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL COUNCILS ALSO INCLUDE THE BOARDING ADMINISTRATOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF BOARDING OR THEIR DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE. THE OFFICERS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS (PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT, SECRETARY, AND TREASURER) ARE NOMINATED FROM AMONG THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE UNIT COUNCILS AND ELECTED BY THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE UNIT COUNCILS. THEY SHALL BE FULL MEMBERS AND PARENTS, LEGAL GUARDIANS, SPONSORS, OR TEACHERS OF A STUDENT ENROLLED AT KAMEHAMEHA SCHOOLS KAPALAMA (KSK) THE OFFICERS ARE NON-VOTING MEMBERS, EXCEPT IN THE CASE OF A TIE VOTE; THE PRESIDENT SHALL HAVE ONE VOTE. THERE ARE FIVE VOTING UNIT COUNCIL DIRECTORS, ONE EACH FOR GRADES K-3, 4-6, 7-8, 9-10, AND 11-12. UNIT COUNCIL DIRECTORS SHALL BE SELECTED BY AND FROM THE PARENT REPRESENTATIVES OF EACH UNIT COUNCIL DIRECTOR. THERE IS ONE VOTING TEACHER DIRECTOR FROM EACH UNIT COUNCIL WHO IS SELECTED BY THE TEACHER REPRESENTATIVES FOR THAT UNIT COUNCIL. THE PRESIDENTS OF NEIGHBOR ISLAND AFFILIATES ORGANIZATIONS, OR THEIR DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVES, WHO ARE FULL MEMBERS, SHALL BE NEIGHBOR ISLAND DIRECTORS - EACH WITH ONE VOTE. EACH ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTOR HAS ONE VOTE. ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTORS ARE THE HIGH SCHOOL PRINCIPAL, THE MIDDLE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL, THE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PRINCIPAL, THE BOARDING ADMINISTRATOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF BOARDING, OR THEIR DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE. THE VOTE OF ONE ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTOR IS REQUIRED TO PASS ANY MOTION WHICH MAY AFFECT THE TAX-EXEMPT STATUS OF KSK OR THE ASSOCIATION, CREATE POTENTIAL LEGAL OR FINANCIAL EXPOSURE FOR KSK, OR POTENTIALLY BE INTERPRETED AS INCONSISTENT WITH THE MISSION, VISION OR GOALS OF KSK. THE KSK PARENT AND ALUMNI RELATIONS DIRECTOR SHALL SERVE AS AN EX-OFFICIO NON-VOTING MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS.
