Camp Sunshine has no full time staff. Business operations are run by a volunteer board and individuals who work independently and meet
periodically throughout the year. Virtually all funds collected are used to provide high quality programming for the children who attend camp.
In addition to collecting donations, the volunteer board conducts miscellaneous fund raisers throughout the year. Funds are used to support
camp and provide camperships for needy families. Our goal is that families should pay no more than they might pay for a typical child to attend
a similar program, even though we must provide much more intense supervision and adult support to meet the needs of children with a range
of disabilities. We also provide camperships for children whose families cannot afford some or all of the family portion of the camp.
Camp Sunshine was started by a small group of parents of children with special needs to bridge summer gap between school sessions.
It provides a four week integrated program out of a single location where children with disabilities can learn and have fun together rather than
requiring parents to travel to multiple locations where unrelated therapies are provided. Over the past ten years, Camp Sunshine has grown from
1 to 5 classes of children with a wide range of disabilities. School skills are reinforced throughout camp so children have little or no regression
when school starts in the fall. Camp Sunshine trains and includes typically developing peers who participate throughout all activities. Peers
not only model for the children with disabilities, but they learn and practice how to interact with other children whose communication and
movement may be very different than their own. While spending time together, the children learn that they all play and enjoy the same things;
a valuable lesson for everyone.
One hundred percent of net fundraising goes to experiences for the children. A volunteer board runs all camp business operations and fund
raising as a "Labor of Love." Camp is costly since many of the children have significant needs and require a high level of adult care and
supervision. We pay for the best teachers, aides and interns we can find. Funds are also used to provide a wide range of community experiences
so the children can practice their skills across multiple setting while enjoying all that a summer camp has to offer. Field trips are not only fun
for the children, but an opportunity to learn and practice very valuable social and living skills. Most of our children need constant practice and
reminders with social skills such as: keeping an inside voice, waiting patiently in lines, appropriate communication, making eye contact with others,
and interacting with peers.
Camp Sunshine was created for the children. In a world that may seem big and overwhelming. Camp Sunshine is a place where a child
with disabilities can find consistency, reassurance, fun and meaningful interaction with other children. We are proud to give them that
