THE FOUNDATION SHALL BE OPERATED EXCLUSIVELY FOR RELIGIOUS, CHARITABLE, LITERARY OR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES, EITHER DIRECTLY OR BY CONTRIBUTIONS TO INDIVIDUALS AND ORGANIZATIONS DULY AUTHORIZED AND PERMITTED BY LAW.
