An Associate member includes someone who runs or operates a farm but whose gross agricultural income is less than half their total income. An Associate member also includes someone working in Agribusiness. Someone who is not directly related to Agriculture is an Associate member. Lastly, an Associate member can hold their membership through a church, FFA chapter, an association or by a corporation not producing agricultural products. A Voting member can be a family member that gets the majority of its average gross income from the sale of agricultural products. A Voting member can also be held by a retired agricultural person living on an income or social security accrued and not employed full time in another occupation. A Voting member can also be held by a partnership or corporation receiving the majority of income from the sale of agricultural products.
