

Imm ediately upon acquisition, PIH Health began its due diligence to ensure GSH was in complia nce with the requirements of Section 501 (r). As of the date of acquisition, GSH became subject to PIH Health's existing Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP), which was approved by the PIH Health board of directors in December 2019.
