

However, the Bylaws of NCH and each Hospital identify certain "Major matters" (divided into organizational and operational matters) that require initiation and/or authorization by a majority of the NCH Board Members of the Hospital Boards are nominated exclusively by the Hospitals. However, the election of any such director must be approved by both the Hospital Board and the NCH Board Some examples of other organizational "Major matters" requiring the initiation and/or approval of the NCH Board include amendments to by-laws, election of officers, dissolution of a Hospital, merger decisions and hiring/termination of Hospital Presidents Examples of operational "Major matters" requiring the initiation and/or approval of the NCH Board include approval of annual capital and operating budgets, adoption of compensation and ben efit programs, approval of information technology systems, financial systems and auditors, plus approval of any major changes to clinical services offered. The Chief Executive Officer position at each of the Hospital base been changed to a President position. As with Board members, each Hospital Board and the NCH Board. This position reports to both the applicable Hospital Board and the Chief Executive Officer of NCH. The Chief Financial Officer of each of the Hospitals will remain an appointed position by the President, but this individual will also report to the President/Chief Financial Officer of NCH.
