The Act impacts the System in several ways, including new excise taxes on e xecutive compensation, increases to UBTI by the amount of certain fringe benefits for which a deduction is not allowed, changes to the net operating loss rules, repeal of the alternative minimum tax ("AMT"), and the computation of UBTI separately for each unrelated trade or business. Further, the Act reduces the U.S. federal corporate tax rate and federal corporate unrelated business income tax rate from 35% to 21%. The overall impact of the Act has not been material to the System. For the years ended September 30, 2019 and 2018, the System had approximately \$11,520,000 and \$15,500,000 of net operating loss ("NOL") carryforwards for federal income tax purposes primarily related to its previously discontinued laboratory outreach business. The NOL carryforwards have expiration dates from 2028 through 2035. In compliance with the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017, the federal components of the deferred tax assets were revalued from 35% to 21%.
