Election Under Treasury Regulation Section 53.4942(a)-3(c)(2)(iv)

The High Q Foundation, Inc. ("High Q") made three grants to CHDI Foundation, Inc. ("CHDI") during CHDI's taxable year ending October 31, 2019, as follows:

- (i) \$50,000,000 on March 7, 2019,
- (11) \$60,000,000 on August 15, 2019, and
- (iii) \$24,000,000 on October 10, 2019.

(collectively, the "2019 Grants"). High Q reported each of the 2019 Grants as a "qualifying distribution" within the meaning of section 4942(g)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (the "Code") for High Q's taxable year ending November 30, 2019.

In order to satisfy the requirements of Code section 4942(g)(3) and Treasury Regulations section 53.4942(a)-3(c) in connection with the 2019 Grants, CHDI hereby elects pursuant to Treasury Regulations section 53.4942(a)-3(c)(2)(iv) to treat as current distributions out of corpus the minimum amount necessary to satisfy such requirements with respect to the 2019 Grants. Specifically, subject to any future adjustment as described in the following paragraph, CHDI hereby elects to treat as current distributions out of corpus \$134,000,000 of its excess qualifying distributions carryover from its taxable year ending October 31, 2014, as listed on line 3a of Part XIII.

CHDI believes that the amount covered by this election is \$134,000,000, consisting as described above entirely of a portion of its excess qualifying distributions carryover from its taxable year ending on October 31, 2014. However, if it is later determined that a different amount is the minimum amount necessary to satisfy the requirements of Code section 4942(g)(3) and Treasury Regulations section 53.4942(a)-3(c) with respect to the 2019 Grants, then this election shall cover such different amount, and such amount shall be comprised of CHDI's excess qualifying distributions carryovers from its taxable years ending on October 31 of 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, and 2018, in that order.

In accordance with Treasury Regulations section 53 4942(a)-3(c)(2)(iv), CHDI confirms that the above-described \$134,000,000 of excess qualifying distributions carryover from CHDI's taxable year ending on October 31, 2014, or, if different, that portion of its qualifying distributions carryover(s) that is later determined to be covered by this election pursuant to the preceding paragraph, (i) was treated under Treasury Regulations section 53.4942(a)-3(d)(1)(iii) as a distribution out of corpus for such year; (ii) has not been availed of by CHDI for any other purpose; (iii) occurred within the preceding 5 years of CHDI's taxable year ending October 31, 2019; and (iv) will not later be availed of by CHDI for any other purpose. Further, in accordance with Treasury Regulations section 53.4942(a)-3(c)(2)(i), CHDI has no remaining undistributed income for its taxable year ending October 31, 2019 or any prior taxable year.
