

THE FOUNDATION IS ALSO INTERESTED IN EFFORTS TO ENCOURAGE YOUNG PEOPLE TO DEVELOP AN INTEREST IN MATH, SCIENCE, AND BUSINESS. THE FOUNDATION, THEREFORE, GIVES CONSIDERATION TO PROPOSALS DESIGNED TO HELP MAINTAIN STUDENTS' CURIOSITY AND EXCITEMENT ABOUT THE WORLDS OF MATH AND SCIENCE AND TO EXPLORE THE WORLD OF INDUSTRY AND BUSINESS. THE FOUNDATION IS PARTICULARLY INTERESTED IN HELPING YOUNG PEOPLE AND THEIR TEACHERS UNDERSTAND THE RELEVANCE OF MATH AND SCIENCE TO SOCIETY, AND IS SUPPORTIVE OF EFFORTS TO LINK THE MATH AND SCIENCE TAUGHT IN CLASSROOMS TO THE APPLICATION OF THESE DISCIPLINES IN THE WORKPLACE.
