

The Foundation was created under 501(c)(3) of the internal revenue code of 1986 as a supporting organization of the USGA. The Foundation's primary objective is to provide financial support to the United States Golf Association as it carries out its programs, activities and projects designed to advance its charitable mission. The Foundation filed application in December of 2019 for a determination letter from the IRS, which is currently pending.
