Effective July 1, 1992, the fund receives 15% of the gross proceeds from the sale of all lots, graves and niches. As also required by New York State law, effective, January 1, 2001, the fund receives an additional \$35 for each interment. New York State law also provides that the principal of this fund shall remain inviolate except under limited circumstances, as set forth in the law. Income (interest and dividends) from the investments of this fund is deposited in the General Fund to be used for current maintenance of the Cemetery. Capital gains and losses from investments are added to or reduce the principal of the fund.

The Declaratory Maintenance Fund - was established in 1934 as provided in the judgment in an action in the Supreme Court, Westchester

County, entitled The Kensico Cemetery, plaintiff against William H. Lyon, et al, defendants. Pursuant to the judgment, investments of the

General Fund having a book value of \$147,551 were transferred to this fund. The judgment provides that the principal and income of this fund shall not be used for the general purposes of the Cemetery until the fund, including accumulated income, is in an amount sufficient to produce income to maintain in perpetuity the grounds of the Cemetery. This fund has been administered in accordance with the provisions
