If a potential conflict is discovered, it is brought to the attention of the Executive Director or President, who will then assume responsibility for the investigation. Once the investigation is complete, findings are brought to the board of directors who then determine the appropriate action. Any conflicted board member shall not vote or use personal influence of the said matter. Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 15 - In the October board meeting an annual performance review is conducted of both the CEO and COO. This review includes review of performance against the strategic plan and research of comparable organization compensation. There is a policy and process that guides how and how often these reviews are performed. Form 990, Part VI, Section C, Line 19 - The governing documents and financial statements are available upon request from the organization.
