Erowid Center supports and trains libraries, publishers, and other information distributors on issues related to our field. Further, it is Erowid Center's goal to support medical, legal, scientific, academic, and independent experts in developing and publishing related resources.

1. DrugsData / EcstasyData Lab Drug Checking & Analysis

Erowid Center runs a laboratory drug checking program that analyzes the contents of samples of psychoactive drugs including: novel psychoactive substances (NPS); ecstasy tablets and powders; research chemicals; street heroin, fentanyl and other opioids; and pharmaceuticals. Samples are submitted to a DEA-licensed laboratory and the results are published online at DrugsData.org. This project also collects, manages, reviews, and presents laboratory testing results from other US and international organizations. The information is made publicly available to help harm-reduction efforts, medical personnel, researchers and the public. In 2019, 573 samples were tested through the project. These results were published along with results for an additional 626 samples tested by other organizations. An average of 14,782 people viewed these results online each day.

2. Archiving & Transcription of Historical Documents

Erowid Center's mission includes collecting, organizing, and preserving resources about psychoactives as historical records for the future. In 2019, Erowid's primary document archiving project was archiving of Alexander and Ann Shulgin's personal papers, photographs, documents, and books. Erowid also began the process of archiving a portion of Dale Pendell's library, as well as accepting smaller physical collections of personal papers from anonymous experts in related fields to be organized, indexed, preserved, and eventually made publicly available. Erowid Center continues to maintain and upgrade a physical space designed to allow processing of historical archive collections (organizing, scanning, photographing, and digitizing) as well as permanent storage of such library archives/collections.

3. Public Online Information Services

Erowid Center developed, maintained, and provided free access to an online collection of more than 88,300 documents, images, and other media files related to psychoactive plants and drugs. More than 12 million visitors accessed the information in this online archive in 2019. The collection contains essays and articles authored by a broad spectrum of contributors including health care professionals, substance abuse counselors, toxicologists, chemists, therapists, law enforcement agents, lawyers, anthropologists, experiential experts, writers, media, educators, and the general public. Note that the Experience Reports Collection is tracked as a separate program service.

Erowid Center has a diverse set of volunteers, from senior researchers to policy makers, from health care workers to professors, from informed parents to college-age drug geeks. In 2019, Erowid Center had over 1,550 volunteers on its volunteer email list, 173 new volunteers signed up as content reviewers, and there were 40 active Experience Report volunteers. Volunteers reviewed and edited content, found and summarized news stories relevant to our educational mission, entered drug checking results, visited physical libraries to locate reference materials, helped with archiving projects, and triaged or reviewed Experience Reports. Erowid volunteers contributed 1,500–2,000 combined hours, though we do not ask volunteers to document their time.

1. DrugsData / EcstasyData Lab Drug Checking — (expenses: \$109,526, grants: \$0, revenue: \$53,680.00)

Erowid Center runs a laboratory drug checking program that analyzes the contents of samples of psychoactive drugs, including: novel psychoactive substances (NPS); ecstasy tablets and powders; research chemicals; street heroin, fentanyl and other opioids; and pharmaceuticals. Samples are submitted to a DEA-licensed laboratory and the results are published online at DrugsData.org. This project also collects, manages, reviews, and presents laboratory testing results from other US and international organizations. The information is made publicly available to help harm-reduction efforts, medical personnel, researchers and the public. In 2019, 573 samples were tested through the project. These results were published along with results for an additional 626 samples tested by other organizations. An average of 14,782 people viewed these results online each day.

2. Archiving & Transcription of Historical Documents — (expenses: \$84,220, grants: \$0, revenue: \$0)

Erowid Center’s mission includes collecting, organizing, and preserving resources about psychoactives for the historical record. In 2019, Erowid’s primary document archiving project was cataloging Alexander and Ann Shulgin’s personal papers, photographs, documents, and books. We also began the process of archiving a portion of author/poet Dale Pendell’s library, as well as accepting smaller physical collections of personal papers from anonymous experts in related fields to be organized, indexed, preserved, and eventually made publicly available. Erowid Center continues to maintain and upgrade a physical space designed to allow processing of historical archive collections (organizing, scanning, photographing, and digitizing) as well as permanent storage of such library archives/collections.

3. Public Online Information Services — (expenses: \$77,815, grants: \$0, revenue: \$0)

Erowid Center developed, maintained, and provided free access to an online collection of more than 88,300 documents, images, and other media files related to psychoactive plants and drugs. More than 12 million visitors accessed the information in this online archive in 2019. The collection contains essays and articles authored by a broad spectrum of contributors including health care professionals, substance abuse counselors, toxicologists, chemists, therapists, law enforcement agents, lawyers, anthropologists, experiential experts, writers, media, educators, and the general public. Note that the Experience Reports Collection is tracked as a separate program service.

4. Experience Reports Collection — (expenses: \$37,492, grants: \$0, revenue: \$0)

Erowid Center solicits, reviews, and publishes first-hand reports of people’s experiences with psychoactive plants, drugs, and technologies. This produces vital information about novel and classic psychoactive materials as well as aggregate data about why and how people use psychoactives, both for current factual documentation and for the historical record. Researchers, academics, medical professionals, and the public use the results for educational purposes and as data for peer-reviewed articles and publications. Reports are reviewed and edited before being published. Trained volunteers perform a portion of the work under the supervision of Erowid staff. In 2019, Erowid crew completed 4,986 “trriages” (reading and rating an experience report), published 2,602, and ended the year with 36,000 published reports in the collection covering 806 substances. Approximately 25 million experience reports were viewed during the year.

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5. Drug Trend & Novel Psychoactive Substance Tracking — (expenses: \$31,744, grants: \$0, revenue: \$0)
Tracking new psychoactive medicines, technologies, research chemicals, and novel psychoactive substances (NPS) is one of Erowid Center’s areas of expertise. With the objective of educating the public on the risks and benefits associated with emerging drugs, we 1) monitor the availability, use patterns, and effects of these substances through consultation with volunteers, allied organizations, medical professionals, submissions, and online forums; 2) analyze psychoactive chemicals through our DrugsData program (tracked as a separate project), 3) coordinate between experts and researchers in the field; 4) educate writers and authors for media, news, and books; and 5) publish information about these substances, online and in print.

6. Education and Educational Materials, Books, and Gifts — (expenses: \$28,957, grants: \$0, revenue: \$5,665.42)
Erowid Center provided direct education services by answering online questions from the public via email, social media, and other communication systems. Erowid maintains a social media presence via Twitter, Facebook, LinkedIn, and Instagram, through which we publish new information, news and research updates, drug checking results, and answer questions related to psychoactives. We distribute books, handouts, and teaching materials about psychoactive drugs, plants, practices, and technologies to members and the general public, furthering our educational mission.

7. Research, Surveys, & Research Improvement - (expenses: \$11,717 grants: \$0, revenue: \$0)
Erowid improves scientific, medical, and sociological information about psychoactive substances and those who use them by promoting participation in studies and surveys produced by academics, educational institutions, and related organizations. Erowid works directly with scientists—in areas where we have specialized knowledge—to help design credible studies and provide editing, reviewing, and fact-checking for resulting academic publications. Erowid Center’s resources are referenced in hundreds of journal articles, books, and media articles each year. Erowid also conducts and promotes its own surveys about psychoactive drugs: health issues, use patterns, demographics, lifetime perspectives, and trends of newly developed drugs.

8. Events & Conferences — (expenses: \$9,697, grants: \$0, revenue: \$0)
Erowid Center conducts educational outreach in person at conferences, seminars, and festivals. In 2019, Erowid sent representatives to four events. Among these, Erowid staff attended the first meeting of the Alliance for Collaborative Drug Checking in Chicago, and provided outreach at three other events. Erowid also met with supporters, members, writers, and experts in smaller groups to discuss issues related to psychoactive drug education.

9. Information Network - EEN - (expenses: \$4,126, grants: \$0, revenue: \$0)
Erowid Center has built a network of both professionally trained and self-taught experts with knowledge about psychoactive plants, chemicals, and technologies. Erowid Expert Network (EEN) members volunteer to share their expertise for the purpose of educating the public and improving the quality of information about this topic. The EEN facilitates making connections between those who are seeking information and experts who can help them. This furthers Erowid Center's mission by helping to improve both internal and external educational resources through increased fact checking and review.

10. *Erowid Extracts* Educational Newsletter — (expenses: \$3,399, grants: \$0, revenue: \$0)
Erowid Center worked on a future newsletter issue centered on public drug checking and our DrugsData laboratory drug checking program (program expenses tracked separately). Initially, this advertisement-free print publication is distributed to members. A complete digital version and constituent articles are later published online for free access by the general public. More than 13,000 copies of previous issues of *Erowid Extracts* were viewed/downloaded in 2019, and thousands of people read individual articles from previous issues online. Back issues were also distributed at events and conferences and paper issues were sent worldwide for free to related organizations and events.
