General Note: Submission of the 2019 IRS Returns for our organization were delayed significantly by the COVID-19 pandemic. Preparations and adaptations
for health measures and program operations disrupted our normal operations and consumed much leadership time and effort, which was compounded by
a significant loss of volunteer manpower due to health precautions and shelter-in-place mandates. We operate housing and services for the homeless and had
to prioritize their care. COVID-19 also disrupted independent auditor's schedule and lengthened audit process, which delayed board review and submission.
Part VI.11 Board members, staff and volunteer bookkeeping staff are involved in gathering the information for the operations and various programs of The
Journey Home and for the independent auditors. Financial information is reviewed at board meetings and auditor presents report annually to board, typically at
October meeting. Board members receive financial statements and 990 via email.
Part VI.12 All documents referenced are discussed and signed annually at the first board meeting of the calendar year. Staff and auditors check for compliance
throughout the year.
Part VI.15 TJH uses information from non-profit compensation surveys conducted by Guidestar and Center for Non-profit Management as well as local market
and BLS information when reviewing salary and benefits for the annual budget, which is approved annually by the board independent of any staff members.
Part VI.19 TJH makes governing documents available by request at our outreach center. Financial statements and policies are also available through links on
our website as well as Guidestar and GivingMatters websites.
Part IX 24 Due to GAAP changes initially implemented in 2018, the manner in which expenses are reported changed to a natural expense model where previous
years followed a functional model related to program expenses. Therefore, some expenses are grouped together and reported differently. Expenses included
in other expenses include direct service expenses for providing housing such as repairs, maintenance, furnishings and outreach center center programs such as
the direct cost of food and supplies for the feeding and hygiene programs. Housing rents, taxes, utilities and such are classified naturally as rents, taxes, utilities
and the like, as there is a relevant category. In the past, expenses related to these types of direct service programs were classified as assistance to
domestic individuals (line 2).
