PERU: Bless An Orphan operates children's homes and various programs that provide relief to orphaned, abused, abandoned, and children rescued from human trafficking. Our program also provides care and support to young adolescent pregnant girls who were rescued from human trafficking. Our safe homes and children's homes are equipped to meet the physical, spiritual, and mental development of the children. Our mission expands into communities by providing educational and medical resources, feeding programs for impoverished families, and assistance to young girls who are caught up in a life of prostitution. In addition, we work hand in hand with local authorities and have provided emergency food relief to community police officers and rescue workers.

Ecuador: Bless An Orphan provides relief to orphans, abandoned, abused and the at-risk children of Ecuador. Our program focuses on sustainability and long term goals for lasting change. We believe it is important to address the physical, emotional, social, educational, psychological, and spiritual needs of the child so that they may fully recover from trauma. We work with psychologists, therapists, counselors, and other healthcare providers to help meet these needs. In some regions we manage safe homes for children rescued from human trafficking and children's homes for those who have been orphaned, abandoned, or legally removed from abusive homes. Our mission also reaches into impoverished communities through our Matthew 25 Feeding Program, where we provide nutritional support to children, families, elderly, and homeless individuals. We also conduct medical missions to assist the poor or those with no access to healthcare. Part of our mission includes providing educational resources to underprivileged children whose families cannot afford materials or school fees. In some cases we have provided housing support to struggling families, homeless individuals, or single mothers and their children.
