The conference, usually held in April of each year, attracts between 650 and 780 students, faculty and other scholars. This

includes students and faculty from both public and private institutions of higher education, as well as representatives from private and public sector institutions and agencies.

Journal Production: The Social Science Journal has been published by WSSA since 1963. The copyright for the Journal is owned by the Western Social Science Association. The Journal is currently printed, produced and mailed by Elsevier Publishing, who in turn provides royalties from the sale of the Journal to WSSA. The Journal is distributed to about 650 individuals and over 2,000 institutions. The Journal is published four times per year, with occasional special editions. It has a 90 percent rejection rate for submissions. About 40 to 45 scholars per year are published in the Journal. The Journal also provides book reviews.

WSSA News: The WSSA Newsletter is published on-line four times per year. The Newsletter, in addition to promoting the annual conference also promotes new ideas, concepts and trends in the social sciences.
