### EXPLANATION:

THE IDF SEEKS TO INVEST IN EFFORTS TO MAKE SOCIETY MORE JUST AND FREE. WITHIN THIS CATEGORY WE HAVE TWO BROAD FOCUS AREAS: GENDER JUSTICE FOCUSES ON INITIATIVES SEEKING TO CREATE A WORLD WHERE GIRLS AND WOMEN CAN FLOURISH AS FULL EQUALS IN SOCIETY. IMAGO DEI FUND FUNDS THE STUDY OF GENDER PARITY OF WOMEN IN LEADERSHIP POSITIONS WITH EVANGELICAL INSTITUTIONS. THE GOAL OF THE "GENDER LANDSCAPE" STUDY IS TO GET A BROAD SNAPSHOT OF WHERE EVANGELICAL SOCIAL SERVICES AND CHARITIES STOOD WITH RESPECT TO GENDER BALANCE. THE BASIC PURPOSE OF THE STUDY IS TO STEP BACK AND SEE HOW WE MEASURE UP AS A FAITH-BASED SECTOR WITH REGARD TO THE LARGER SOCIAL GOAL OF WORKING TOWARD GENDER PARITY WITHIN ALL OF OUR ORGANIZATIONS AND WORKPLACES.
