

In response to line 16 "Other expenses" in Part I of form 990-EZ, IC Haiti incurred expenses related to a private event held for donors. The event included the viewing of a documentary film "Bending the Arc," which helped to inform donors of the humanitarian work being carried out in Haiti. We rented space for the showing at the Newburyport Community Center and served our guests finger sandwiches, desserts, and non-alcoholic beverages. This was not a fundraising event. Costs related to the event totalled \$378.

In response to line 10 "Grants and similar amounts paid (list in Schedule O)" in Part I of form 990-EZ, IC Haiti listed all such grants, including grant amounts, the intended recipients, and descriptions of the services provided, on lines 28, 29, and 30 in Part III of form 990-EZ
