1	Briefly describe the organization's mission  The mission of Health and Education for Haiti is to work collaboratively with the Haitian people to address their critical needs, especially those related to health and education. We structure our work into four program areas medical missions, education, infrastructure, and basic needs

The on-going political instability in Haiti made travel very unsafe, so we did not conduct any on-site medical missions in 2019. We did pay \$800 for a pharmacist to operate a dispensary in a clinic we support in Leon, Haiti. In addition, we granted a US partner organization \$566 to pay for medical bills for a patient that was referred during one of our medical missions in 2018.

	Health and Education for Haiti's second major program area is education. During 2019 we provided several grants that enabled us to assist over 900 students to attend primary or secondary school. Health and Education for Haiti subsidizes teacher salaries to reduce the overall cost of schooling to make it less expensive for all. Grants of nearly \$31,000 were paid directly to two schools to cover significant portions of teach salaries. Over 900 students attend these two schools. Heart of Jesus School (Grades 1 - 12 with over 750 students) and College Notre Dame (Grades 7 - 12 with over 150 students) benefited from these grants with significantly reduced education costs. College Notre Dame is the only secondary school within a 15 mile radius, so it is an enable for these students who otherwise wouldn't attend secondary school. Additionally, grants totaling nearly \$21,000 were awarded to support the college education of 15 individual students in the Leon region recommended by the Executive Director of the Heart of Jesus School and Orphanage as exceptional students with no other means to obtain the funding to attend University
