The program operates in La Vallee Jacmel, Haiti. Line 28. In 2019, the Student Sponsorship program provided tuition support for 267 students attending 16 primary and secondary schools and 13 post-secondary schools. These sponsorships also provided uniforms, books and supplies as needed.

Name of the organization **Employer identification number** Alliance for Haiti's Children 27-1780946 Line 29: In 2019, the Academic Enrichment program provided an after-school interscholastic competition for area students and a summer enrichment camp. Approximately 2600 students from 16 local schools benefited from these programs. The academic competition among 11 schools provided weekly quiz contests based on the Haitian national curriculum. Students competed for placement on school teams, which then competed against each other. The competition has had demonstrable results, raising passing rates on national exams by 5-30%. The 2019 summer enrichment camp for 171 students from 15 schools included instruction in basic computer literacy, English, Haitian arts and crafts and athletics. Health and hygiene instruction included critical lessons on reproductive health and safety from the Days for Girls program. The two-week camp employed 13 local principals and teachers as classroom leaders and 12 local students as counselors and translators. The camp also provided daily hot lunch and potable water. The Alliance also provided interactive classroom materials, books, computers, software, art materials and athletic equipment for the camp. These materials were donated to local schools and the community library after the camp concluded. The Alliance in 2019 also supported other academic activities, including a community-wide book Line 30:. In 2019, the Alliance supported the LaVallee community by building a new community park and playground. The park provides a safe clean space for students and community members to gather for meetings and studying, with benches and tables for small group gatherings. The park includes a playground with swings and a slide for young children to play while parents socialize. The park has solar powered lighting to allow for evening meetings and study sessions. Through the school garden program, the Alliance also provided training. seeds and materials to create school gardens at 6 elementary schools. Line 31: Other Program Services provided in 2019 included teacher professional development and salary stipends, as well as support for the local library and computer lab. The Alliance supported 44 teachers at 6 schools through a professional development program led by the Centre D'Apprentissage et De Formation Pour La Transformation (CAFT). The 50- hour training program included curriculum development, school leadership, lesson planning and positive classroom management. Principals also received 2 days of instruction in school management and leadership. The Alliance also continued support in 2019 for the only community library and public computer lab in the region, located in a new building provided by the Director Nationale du Livre (DNL). The Alliance provided electrical power to the new building through solar panels and batteries, allowing consistent computer lab power and lighting for nighttime meetings and study sessions. It afforded the community of more than 40,000 people access to computer training and the world of online learning. In 2019, more than 500 students and community members visited the library each month. The Alliance paid the salary of a librarian, who assisted students with computer training, research, typing and copying services. The Alliance also funded basic computer skills courses at the library for high
