	We partnered with our sister organization in Israel to provide humanitarian aid to new immigrants and impoverished Jews in Israel.  We have very little overhead to administer this service so most of the designated funds are sent to provide these needed services.  In Israel, we are helping not only new immigrants but also the elderly, Holocaust survivors, single mothers and the disabled. The mismatch between income and expenses is a matter of end-of-year timing between receiving donations and disbursing the funds.
