

INCLUDING A SPLIT DOLLAR LIFE INSURANCE POLICY AND LONG-TERM CARE INSURANCE, TO INDIVIDUALLY TAILOR A BENEFITS PROGRAM APPROPRIATE TO EACH EXECUTIVE'S NEEDS. THE PLAN PROVIDES ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS A PRE-DETERMINED BENEFITS ALLOWANCE CREDIT THAT IS EOUAL TO A PERCENTAGE OF THE EXECUTIVE'S BASE PAY FROM WHICH IS DEDUCTED THE COST OF MANDATORY AND ELECTIVE EMPLOYEE BENEFITS. THE PRE-DETERMINED BENEFITS ALLOWANCE CREDIT PERCENTAGE IS APPROVED BY THE AHSSHC BOARD COMPENSATION COMMITTEE, AN INDEPENDENT COMMITTEE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF AHSSHC.
