	To provide the basic fire and medical equipment and training needed by firefighters, the Foundation conducts an annual grant
	program for all fire stations in the County with vounteer/reserve firefighters. These stations are first responders protecting over 60%
	of San Diego County. They respond to about 6,000 emergencies annually, about 5,000 of which are medical/rescue calls. To prevent
	he major wildfires of 2003 and 2007, these departments must have the necessary equipment and training to respond quickly and effectively extinguish fires while they are small, in spite of strong winds, heavy fuel and steep rough terrain in San Diego County.
	Medical equipment and training are critical as all volunteers firefighters are EMTs (some are paramedics) and generally will arrive and
	treat patients for 15 to 60 minutes before an ambulance, other medical personnel or a rescue helicopter can arrive on the scene in
	many rural parts of the County. The medical care provided in the field by these firefighters is critical for the survivability of some
	patients and the speed and degree of recovery of other patients.

	After the devastating fires of 2003 and 2007, the County of San Diego engaged the services of an independent consultant to study
	fire services in the County. The consultant's recommendations included having the Fire Foundation take the lead in increasing public awareness about the system of fire protection and what responsibilities individual citizens have in fire prevention and
	preparedness. This awareness is critical given the high loss of lives and properties in these two major fire storms. The Fire
	Foundation has created a web site with information about fire prevention and preparedness and safety precautions individuals can
	take personally. The Fire Foundation also produces a periodic newsletter containing safety tips, accident and fire prevention
	information, and updates on fire and safety events occurring in the community.

	the same level of equipment to expedite dispatching, reduce response times, have needed up-to-date mapping, and work together
	as effectively as possible. The Fire Foundation is coordinating with individual fire stations, the County and State to help make sure
	all equipment is available on all fire and rescue apparatus. To make this consolidation successful, the Fire Foundation is taking both
	a regional approach to communication and fire/medical equipment needs as well as unique station-by-station review of needs.
