White Physical Education Program grant to implement the On Track through Fitness & Nutrition project, a comprehensive physical activity, health, and nutrition program to directly serve 5,000 K-8 students in Buena Park, CA to help them meet State Standards. AOT, with seven collaborative community partners, is using promising
