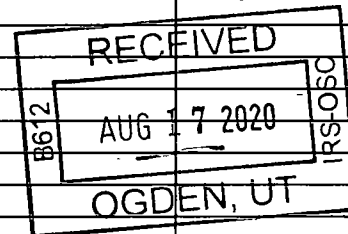

SINCE THE FALL OF 2000, MORE THAN 360 RESIDENCY FELLOWS HAVE BEEN HOUSED IN LANNAN PROPERTIES IN MARFA, TEXAS, A SMALL, BEAUTIFUL, HIGH DESERT RANCHING TOWN IN WEST TEXAS NEAR THE CHINATI MOUNTAINS TO THE SOUTHWEST AND THE DAVIS MOUNTAINS TO THE NORTHEAST. MARFA IS ALSO HOME TO THE INTERNATIONALLY KNOWN CHINATI FOUNDATION, A CONTEMPORARY ART ORGANIZATION FOUNDED BY THE LATE SCULPTOR, DONALD JUDD. LANNAN FOUNDATION RESIDENCIES HAVE PROVIDED CREATIVE INSPIRATION FOR AN UNTOLD NUMBER OF PUBLISHED WORKS OF FICTION, POETRY AND NONFICTION, AND OTHER WORKS OF ART.

CANDIDATES FOR THE RESIDENCY PROGRAM ARE SELECTED THROUGH AN INTERNAL NOMINATION PROCESS. UNSOLICITED APPLICATIONS ARE NOT ACCEPTED.
