Since the event, the Foundation has continued to develop philanthropic, community, educational and governmental collaborations designed to build awareness of the economic and environmental benefits of electric vehicles and support the infrastructure that will allow electric vehicles to become more widely adopted. Recharge Mankato, in conjunction with, Recharge America, Inc., is also implementing a state recognition program in Minnesota for use of electric vehicles.
